MATERIALS:

- 4 3 3/8" x 3 3/8" x 16" legs
- 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" x 26" long skirt members
- 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" x 9 3/4" short skirts members
- 2 3/4" x 4 1/2" x 35 1/2" long support strips
- 2 3/4" x 4 1/2" x 18 1/2" short support strips
- 1 1/4" x 9 1/2" x 26 1/2" glass top
- 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" x 26" box sides
- 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" x 9 3/4" box ends
- 1 1/4" x 9 5/8" x 26 5/8" plywood box bottom
- 2 1 3/8" x 1 3/8" x 25 7/8" long spacers
- 2 1 3/8" x 1 3/8" x 9 3/8" short spacers
- 4 3/4" x 3/4" L. brackets
