As she finally confirms her pregnancy, showing-off her bump in new promotional shots, Cheryl's pals reveal why she kept her baby news a secret

t's been the worstkept secret in showbiz history despite her entire pregnancy being shrouded in mystery, but last week pictures finally emerged of a glowing Cheryl proudly showing-off her baby bump, looking blissfully happy.

The singer, 33, was grinning from ear-to-ear as she revealed her pregnancy curves

off a "bump" at a

in the campaign shot for The Prince's Trust and L'Oréal Paris' collaboration. But fans continued to speculate whether baby "Chiam" had already arrived.

One asked on Twitter: "Is this a sneaky way of saying Cheryl has just given birth?" and another commented on Instagram: "Does that mean she's in labour now?"

FEELING NERVOUS

The former Girls Aloud star has spent the past few months going to every effort to hide her baby news – concealing the bump, never talking about her pregnancy, and keeping a low profile – a move insiders say was motivated by Cheryl's concerns over her much longed-for pregnancy.

A source reveals: "Following two public divorces and wanting

a baby for so long, Cheryl has been nervous about this pregnancy. This is her first child and, understandably, she's apprehensive, so she made a decision not to make a big announcement at the start.

"She was scared that after years of bad luck, she may jinx the best thing that ever happened to her, which prompted her to stay silent – despite the fact she's been wanting to shout about her pregnancy from the rooftops."

The day before the image was released, Cheryl's boyfriend, Liam Payne, 23, attended The BRITs alone.

When *Closer* asked his former bandmate Niall Horan at the Warner BRITs after party how Liam was, he remained coy, saying: "Liam is good – all the guys are."

Last week's BRITs marked exactly a year since rumours over Cheryl's relationship with toyboy Liam broke after the pair were spotted cosying up to one another at the ceremony. This came just after her split from her second husband, Jean-Bernard Fernandez-Versini, following her divorce from Ashley Cole in 2010.

THE PERFECT TIME

Insiders say JB was also part of the reason Cheryl's been so reluctant to talk about her pregnancy. Their divorce was finalised last October, after months of negotiations, with reports the Frenchman was forced to sign a gagging order.

A source says: "Cheryl's been sensitive that her relationship with Liam progressed soon after her marriage breakdown and she was conscious of appearing to rub the pregnancy in JB's face – especially as technically they were still married for part of it."

Earlier this month, fashion photographer Mariano Vivanco teased fans over the anticipated bump shoot when he uploaded a Snapchat captioned: "My divine @cherylofficial," after saying he was "shooting someone very special today." It was quickly deleted. Her hairdresser also posted a video of the star's growing bump on his Instagram account recently, which was swiftly removed.

A source says: "Cheryl's been nervous about revealing her bump, but she said the L'Oréal campaign would be the perfect time to finally show it off, given it was so close to the due date.

"The shoot happened earlier this month. She's relaxed as her pregnancy's gone on and felt better than ever. She wanted to take the opportunity to flaunt her bump and show-off the body she says she feels so proud of."

Closer has previously reported how her former band mate and mum-of-two Kimberley Walsh, 35, has been giving Cheryl advice on how to cope when the baby arrives and pals say she's urged Cheryl – who reportedly has both her mum Joan and Liam's mum Karen on hand to help – not to pressurise herself into losing her baby weight.

FRIENDLY ADVICE

A source says: "Kim's told Cheryl to go easy on herself during the first few weeks with the baby. Cheryl said she feels more confident than ever as Liam keeps telling her how sexy she looks. Starting a family has given her a new lease of life and she's delighting in the idea of finally being able to put the past behind her and to embrace her dream of becoming a mum."



ooking happier and healthier than she has in years, Angelina Jolie last week opened up about how determined she is to come back even stronger after her bitter high-profile break-up from husband Brad Pitt.

The 41-year-old actress

- who split from Brad
last September after 12 years
together - was in Cambodia with
her six children and admitted:
"We're focusing on the health of
our family. We will be stronger
when we come out of this, that's
what we're determined to do."

Giving a glimpse into her new life, the actress added: "I'm going through a moment where there's just... everybody's in my room. Two hamsters and two dogs and two children at the moment. It's wonderful."

And Angelina – who has children Maddox, 15, Pax, 13, Zahara, 12, Shiloh, 10, and eight-year-old twins Knox and Vivienne – now claims she's happier than she's ever been.

A source tells *Closer*: "Angelina is gaining perspective on their split and letting go of a lot of the anguish she was holding on to. After some soul-searching, she's

promote her new Netflix documentary, First They Killed My Father, and pals close to the actress say her life has totally changed.

An insider explains: "Before, it was all about compromise. Brad and

Angelina had very different parenting styles and didn't always agree. Now she's able to do things her way.

"Unlike Brad, Angelina doesn't like to set too many boundaries for the kids; her way is about letting them make mistakes and learn from them. She hates strict bedtimes and encourages them to speak their mind – she welcomes them being outspoken like she was growing up."

Angelina was the target of a Hollywood backlash as A-listers sided with Brad, claiming she had tried to paint him as a bad dad. But now, despite the ongoing custody battle, Angelina is looking forward to a bright future.

Speaking about the split for the first time, she said: "It was very difficult. My focus is my children, our children. We are and forever will be a family."

"Before, she'd often stay up late with Brad or feel obliged to attend an event he wanted to go to. Now she's free to get an early night, so she's been getting up earlier and likes doing cardio workouts and yoga in the mornings.

"The rest of the day she'll spend checking in on the kids' homeschooling. When they finish their work they accompany her wherever she's going. She spends lots of time with them which she loves – motherhood's everything to her."

Despite a wave of antipathy towards her since the split, Angelina remains a global icon, campaigning for refugees for the UN and speaking out about violence against women.

The insider adds: "She loves being able to express her true self again, which she felt has been lost over the years. She's got her groove back."

CLOSER'S PSYCHOLOGIST EMMA KENNY SAYS: "Like Angelina, the average age of a woman going through divorce is between 40-44.

"Obviously it can be devastating. It usually means the breakdown of a family unit, financial arguments and fear of the unknown.

"But becoming single in your 40s can be hugely empowering, as Angelina and Kylie are discovering - so long as you approach it in the right way. You have to see it as a chance to focus on yourself.

"In long-term relationships, you can lose your sense of self over time. After a breakup, it's helpful to concentrate on the future and something new; find a new hobby, join a new fitness class or go on an exciting holiday.

"Treat your body with respect by eating well and exercising regularly, which will make you feel better in

itself. Do things for yourself; socialise with family, catch up with old friends and make new ones - don't spend too much time on your own.

"You may find yourself craving a relationship, but rushing into another romance could cause more hurt in the long run.

Despite cruel weight jibes, pals say Kelly Brook is feeling more contented than ever

he's one of the UK's most successful models, yet Kelly Brook has faced taunts about her hourglass figure over the years, with everyone from Jordan to Katie Hopkins making jibes about her weight.

Last week was no exception, when unflattering photos of the 37-year-old surfaced and trolls branded her "fat, old and cheap." Newspaper columnist Kelvin MacKenzie wrote: "If she carries on like this she will go from page 3 to page 33," cruelly adding that he'd see her at Slimming World.

SUPPORT NETWORK

A source says: "Kelly tries to ignore the trolls, but it is upsetting. She calls her friends and family for support, and her boyfriend Jeremy [Parisi] is great. She's determined not to let people she doesn't know bring her down."

Just days earlier, Kelly - who has reportedly earned £8m from modelling - had confessed in an interview she feels self-conscious stripping for photo shoots, saying: "I'm still amazed that they want me to do my calendar. That's the only time of the year I go: 'Oh God, I've got to put on a bikini and have my picture taken.' Now I feel like a normal woman. I'm just as self-conscious as anyone."

Kelly was launched into the spotlight on C4's The Big Breakfast in 1999.

Her weight has fluctuated over the years, going from a size 8 to a 12, but she's always accepted her curves. In 2013, she said: "I've got huge boobs and bum. That's just the way I've been built."

But sources say after years of dieting, Kelly – who regularly uploads Instagram shots of herself enjoying eating out - has reached a point where she wants to relax.

A source says: "She spent her 20s and early 30s working on a model body. She's gradually put on a bit of weight over the past two years, as she believes there's now

more to life than juicing. She's now a size 12 to 14 and is much happier.



CHILD SEX GANG VICTIM:

'I was abused for two years — I'm glad Corrie is tackling this horror'



As a hard-hitting soap storyline is highlighting the extent of child grooming, Closer speaks to Alex, who experienced a hellish ordeal at the hands of a sex ring

A

t just 14, Alex was thrilled to be lavished with expensive jewellery

and flashy new phones.

The gifts came from her new older "friends," brothers Shamin Uddin, 30, and Giash Uddin, 31, and their friend Robert Jackson, 27. But she had no idea these men were grooming her to eventually sleep with other men.

Although shocking, Alex's story is far from an isolated case. There have been many other appalling high-profile cases of children being

exploited in sex rings.

The Rotherham child abuse scandal revealed around 1,400 children were subjected to sexual exploitation between 1997 and 2013, with a report finding South Yorkshire police had failed to prioritise the issue.

CHILD SEX PARTIES

Earlier this month, six members of the child sex gang were jailed for a combined total of 80 years for grooming and abusing girls, one of whom fell pregnant at 12.

And, in 2013, a sadistic gang of seven men in Oxford groomed six girls aged 11 to 15 before selling them for sex at "parties."

Coronation Street is tackling the issue in its latest storyline, which sees 16-year-old Bethany Platt (Lucy Fallon) being groomed by Nathan Curtis (Chris Harper), who's 20 years her senior.

It makes for uncomfortable viewing and some fans have complained the subject matter is "too dark." But experts believe it's important to raise awareness.

An NSPCC spokesperson says: "It's great *Corrie* is running this storyline because it shines a light on the grooming process and how sexual predators can target and manipulate vulnerable



young people. Parents need to be vigilant about the relationships their child is forming, and should have regular conversations with them. TV programmes can help facilitate these discussions."

LIFE DESTROYED

Alex, now 22, suffered two years of abuse at the hands of the Uddins and Jackson. She has bravely waived her anonymity – though Closer has witheld her surname to protect her – and says: "I'm glad Coronation Street is raising awareness about child sex rings. It might be upsetting, but it almost destroyed my life and we need to prevent other girls becoming victims.

"I was flattered by the attention from the men that groomed me – but soon they started giving me drink and drugs and eventually started making me have sex with other

CORRIE'S LUCY FALLON:

'Watching the grooming scenes makes me uncomfortable'

Actress Lucy Fallon, 21, who plays victim Bethany Platt, has admitted she finds watching the gritty grooming scenes tough.

She says: "I haven't actually watched it yet because it does make me feel quite uncomfortable, as it does for a lot of the viewers. But it's so important that we do it, especially at this time because we're targeting people who watch *Coronation Street*, who are young."

She adds that the storyline is set to get more sinister: "What [Bethany] doesn't realise is Nathan's not in it for the same reasons she is. She's gradually falling in love, but he's only sticking around while he can get something out of it – and where that's going is pretty scary."

men. I'd hate for anyone else to go through the same ordeal."

Alex was just 14 when the gang targeted her. She explains: "I came from a strict Christian family and was a normal teenager. I met Shamin in 2010 through a friend, who invited me to join them on a night out - it sounded fun.

"I told Mum I was staying at a friend's. Shamin drove a flash car and was a smooth talker; I was impressed. At the end of the night we shared a bottle of Jack Daniel's at his house. I'd never drunk before, so it went to my head and I agreed to have sex with him.

"The next morning I was shocked by what I'd done - I'd only slept with one guy before - but thought it made me grown up. I believed he was my boyfriend."

Alex started seeing Shamin regularly. She says: "He made me feel like an adult at an age when I craved to be taken seriously. Mum had a new boyfriend, so I was keen to have a life myself. They'd buy me jewellery and phones."

TAKING DRUGS

But within weeks, the gang started plying Alex with class A drugs. She explains: "They encouraged me to take ecstasy and cocaine. Shamin and his friends were all doing it and made it seem normal."

But with Alex on drugs, Shamin began raping her, then forcing her to have sex with other men too.

She says: "I was so out of it I didn't know what I was doing. I'd drink more to block things out, and hoped it'd be over quickly. I tried to distance myself, but they'd send me messages telling me they'd hurt

my family."

The abuse escalated. Alex says: "Me and a friend would be taken to a hotel in Manchester or London, while men had sex with us. It was terrifying.

"Mum was worried but I didn't know how to tell her. My behaviour became worse - I'd go missing and Mum would tell the police, but they thought I was just being an unruly teenager."

At 16, the gang lost interest in her. She adds: "They started looking for new, younger, girls and I was able to start leading a more normal life again."

In 2013, police approached Alex after another victim of the gang reported them and she was asked to give evidence. She recalls: "I was scared, but I wanted to make sure it couldn't happen to anyone else."

In October that year at Manchester Crown Court, the Uddins and Jackson were convicted of charges including rape and drug possession and were jailed for a total of 37 years.

Alex has now rebuilt her life, but wants to warn other girls. She adds: "The gang preyed on me when I was just an innocent child. They've destroyed my childhood and I'm having counselling to cope with the horrific memories. But they won't destroy my future." By Poppy Danby

DANIELLE AND JAMIE START A NEW FEUD

Relations between the exes hit an all-time low as pregnant Danielle Lloyd lashes out at ex Jamie O'Hara for slamming her on Twitter

fter their bitter split in 2014, Danielle Lloyd appeared ready to end the hostility with her ex Jamie O'Hara when she recently told Closer she didn't want to fight any more.

But just a week later, a new feud erupted between the pair, with the ex-footballer claiming Danielle had prevented him from seeing their sons.

Jamie, 30, lashed out on Twitter over missing a visit with his sons, explaining he had lost his keys, and that he would have to "go to court" if he wanted to see them.

FLYING OFF THE HANDLE

Earlier this month, Danielle, 33 – who has Archie, six, Harry, five, and George, three, with Jamie - told Closer: "Jamie and I will remain civil for the children. We have three boys together, but we definitely can't be friends."

But last week she was accused of "flying off the handle" by her ex, amid reports his girlfriend Elizabeth Tierney had offered to collect the children when

he was unable to.

It quickly escalated into public mudslinging between the pair.

Danielle - who is three months pregnant by her electrician fiancé Michael

O'Neill - insisted Jamie has repeatedly failed to show up for visits with his sons.

She posted online: "As a single mother, my children are the main priority and I'm concerned about Jamie's ability to be a father."

The pair's relationship has been frosty since Danielle ended their three-year marriage in 2014, having discovered Jamie had been unfaithful.

Relations hit an all-time low in June 2016 when Michael was arrested after a fight broke out between him and Jamie. Jamie had gone to drop off his children at Danielle's house and a row erupted over car seats. A brawl then broke out between Michael and Jamie in the garden,



The former childhood classmates were inseparable growing up, with a then unknown Kim only identified as "Paris'


best friend." Speaking about their friendship, Kim said: "We'd go anywhere just to be seen."

WHAT MADE A BRIGHT, SUCCESSFUL WOMAN FALL FOR A TWISTED

CONMAN?

Last week, evil lan Stewart was jailed for the murder of his fiancée Helen Bailey. Here we examine how he managed to fool her...



t 51, Helen Bailey was a successful children's author with a £4m

fortune, several properties and a seemingly loving partner. But behind her back, her fiancé Ian Stewart was plotting to murder her for her fortune.

WHIRLWIND ROMANCE

In 2011, manipulative Stewart, 56, befriended Helen – whose first husband had tragically drowned – through a Facebook bereavement group.

Stewart, who Helen called her "gorgeous grey-haired widower," as he'd also lost his own partner in 2010, ended up moving in with her. Three years later, he began slipping sleeping pills into her food and, in April 2016, suffocated her and dumped her body in the cesspit of their £1.3m home in Royston, Herts, along with their dachshund, Boris.

So what made Helen – who a neighbour described as a "beautiful, classy, intelligent lady" – fall for the charms



of a sickening murderer?

Criminologist
Elizabeth
Yardley explains:
"Stewart breezed
into Helen's life
like a knight
in shining
armour. She

was vulnerable after losing her husband and he preyed upon that. But he wanted her lifestyle and money for himself. He had an inflated sense of self and would have been threatened by her success, and possibly even by her love for her dog.

"It was a whirlwind relationship and he moved things along to get what he wanted. Helen was intelligent, but men like this are master manipulators and good at controlling people. Their victims will not realise it's happening."

Stewart, a former software engineer – who had sons Jamie, 24, and Oliver, 21, from his previous marriage, and had convinced Helen to leave almost all of her assets to him – reported her missing four days after killing her. He paid for flyers appealing for help, but also went on holiday and used her bank accounts.

SUSPICIOUS BEHAVIOUR

Gradually police grew suspicious of his behaviour and he was arrested. After a six-week trial at St Alban's Crown Court, he was found guilty of charges including murder, fraud and preventing a lawful burial. He was jailed for a minimum of 34 years.

HELEN AND HER DOG,

BORIS, WERE MURDERED

The death of his previous wife, Diane, from an epileptic fit, is now being investigated.

Elizabeth adds: "You have to question what happened in Stewart's past to make him behave like this. His selfish pursuit of his own desires may have resulted in people being hurt before."

"Iodie Marsh has no idea how she would react to this situation - she's not even a mother, let alone the mother of a missing child. Nobody has a clue what they'd do until they're thrown into a situation where they're living daily with the nightmare of having a child go missing.

"Of course anyone including myself - would be digging the dirt with our hands if we thought we'd find our child. But I'd also be fighting to clear my name against any false accusations. Gerry and Kate have every right to ensure they keep their reputations intact. Their other kids will read these reports and may well ask why their

parents didn't defend themselves, if they don't do so. I've been very lucky with the support I've had, and only ever received the odd negative comment, but even those few remarks devastated me.

"The McCanns have had to fight to beat off critics from every direction, which is horrific. They're in a no-win situation - if they ignore such accusations, people will say they aren't fighting them because they're true. On the flip side, when they fight back some people say it's because they have something to hide.

"I know what it's like to live with the pain of wondering whether you will see your child again - every day is a battle. Jodie doesn't have the right to judge."





he's famous for her formidable attitude and tough exterior, but this time last year, the seemingly unstoppable Katie Hopkins

was told by doctors she had just two years to live – something that left her terrified even as she put on a brave face in public.

Last March, Katie, 42, made the difficult decision to undergo an operation to remove part of her brain to finally rid her of epilepsy – and the torment of her 20-year battle with violent fits.

As Closer sits down with Katie, she looks worlds away from the villainous role she portrays on TV. Debuting her pale pink pixie

haircut, she exudes positivity and laughs her way through the interview, saying she feels "the best she's ever felt," even inviting us to touch her 32cm head scar.

While still as strong and defiant as ever, she's surprisingly sweet. Katie even exposes her vulnerable side while describing her struggle with the neurological condition.

TOUGH TALKING

Katie says: "Having epilepsy made me tough. When people moan about things in their life – things that aren't permanent, and are reasonably easy to fix – I don't tolerate it."

The former *Apprentice* contestant was diagnosed with epilepsy aged 19 and

spent her 20s and 30s "coping" with the condition. At that time, she'd only suffer fits at night – and occasionally when having a nap in the daytime.

But her fits became more frequent in her 40s, when she'd endure five a night. And in 2015, she experienced a terrifying episode where she collapsed in the middle of the street. The fit was so violent that she knocked her teeth out.

It was then Katie had an epiphany and realised the disorder was controlling her life. She says: "After that fit, I lost all my confidence. I stopped imagining life beyond 45. I started to worry about when my fits were going to happen – where would I be?

She says: "Every time I tried to sit down with the children, I just couldn't tell them. I made a 'Folder Of Doom,' which had everything the children would need if it didn't go well. I'd written family birthday cards before the operation just in case.

"I made a deal with my parents that we wouldn't say goodbye beforehand, because if we had, we'd have broken down. So when they came to look after the kids, we passed each other in the hallway and didn't speak."

But after her 12-hour operation, Katie was

at her most vulnerable and it's an ongoing battle relearning to use the left side of her body.

"I was scared of the operation," she says. "But now I'm not scared of anything at all. Don't get me wrong, it was tough and still is. I had to relearn everything walking, running, skipping. My left leg doesn't know where it is and I have to consciously think

about moving the left side of my body. But I feel the best I've ever felt."

Katie credits Mark, 52, with helping her through her recovery. She says: "My husband was amazing. While I had drains attached to $my\,head\,and\,I\,was\,p^{***}ing\,into\,a\,cardboard$ box, he was there for me. I mean, that is love!

"I used to be adamant that long hair was about vanity, but when you lose your hair, it is absolutely horrible. People look at you like you are the walking dead.

CELEBS WITH EPILEPSY

MARTIN KEMP: Spandau **Ballet's Martin Kemp** has suffered from epilepsy since having brain surgery in 1995. He revealed his wife helps him through and says: "I've been on medication for something like 18 years now.'



EDITH BOWMAN: The Radio 1 presenter said she grew out of epilepsy aged nine. "I was weaned off medication and I've been fine since then," she reveals. "I never regarded myself as an invalid - it toughens you up."



SUSAN BOYLE: BGT star Susan Boyle says she was teased at school for having epilepsy. She said: "All through my childhood, people would say epilepsy is to do with mental function... now I realise it's not. I was up against those



"Mark loves my short hair and I care less about how my body looks. Humour keeps our sex life spicy - my husband's funny and he has a large penis and a lot of patience."

But Katie admits she can't shake the fear her children could suffer from epilepsy too.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

Welling up, she says: "It would be an absolute horror if any of my children developed epilepsy. I know what it's like to hide the truth and persuade everyone you're OK when you're not - so it would absolutely kill me."

In the meantime, she's enjoying her new epilepsy-free life and is looking forward. She says: "Before the operation I stopped talking about the future when people were talking about things like their children going to university I'd mentally check out of the conversation. But after my operation, I feel like I'm a capable mum again. I feel invincible." By Lily Smith





WHY IT'S GOOD TO ABOUT DEPRESSIO

In a week where celebrities including Amanda Holden and Michelle Dewberry opened up about their personal struggles with depression, we look at why it's healthy to challenge the stigma and admit when you're not coping...

The Apprentice's Michelle Dewberry was "on the edge of killing herself" until mum's intervention

t's an illness that
can affect anyone,
regardless of age, race or
gender – yet many of us
would still be reluctant
to admit to a mental health problem.

Alarmingly, research shows that while one-in-four of us is likely to experience a mental health issue at some point in our lives, we struggle when it comes to being open about it.

And celebrities aren't immune to it – stars including Fearne Cotton, Michelle Dewberry, Amanda Holden and Mel C have recently talked honestly about their battles with mental health.

CELEBS SPEAK OUT

After the heartbreaking loss of her stillborn son Theo in 2011 – and the trauma of nearly dying while giving birth to Hollie a year later – actress Amanda, 46, revealed she sought "therapy for one month" after suffering with post-traumatic stress syndrome.

And while Mel C, 43, appeared to be living the dream in the Spice Girls, in reality she struggled with "depression, eating disorders and obsessive over-exercising" – and still suffers with "bouts of depression."

Former radio host Fearne, 35, also admitted she only found solace after seeking support, saying: "I felt anti-social, cut-off, alienated, and they were massive warning signs. It was

a relief when the doctor identified what was happening. I was given anti-depressants. I cut back on work and focused more on family."

And despite being on the brink of suicide in 2012, The Apprentice star Michelle Dewberry, 37, revealed last week it was only after speaking with her mum – who urged her to see her GP - that she realised she had depression.

MENTAL HEALTH STIGMA

According to Closer's therapist, Emma Kenny, having celebrities speak out about their experience will help to

erase the stigma surrounding

mental illness.

She says: "When you hear about other people's experiences with mental disorders, it helps to remind us that it's normal. The more we speak up, the more likely it is that judgemental attitudes

will disappear and people will feel more comfortable about being honest."

And Emma says that speaking out about depression is often the first step to improving overall wellbeing. She says: "One of the consequences of depression is that it leaves you feeling lonely and emotionally isolated, but if you acknowledge that these feelings exist, and let someone know, it's the first step to feeling more connected - and that in itself is a powerful anti-depressant.

"Most sufferers spend ages bottling it up before deciding to speak out, and

by this point their situation may have deteriorated. But a problem shared really can be a problem halved. Talking to friends or family can be as good as therapy," she says. "Having someone you can trust enough to be open with can be a powerful tool."



PERSONAL SHAME

"The stigma attached to mental health can make it harder for us to speak up because we fear the consequences. It can bring about feelings of personal shame. In reality, mental health disorders are so common that your friends, colleagues and even your family members will have experienced it in one form or another. Being honest about the way you feel can actually be quite liberating and might encourage other people to do so too. These days, mental health is taken very seriously in the workplace and you're more likely to receive a more empathetic response." By Neeru Sharma







HELP LIFT THE DARK CLOUD

Closer's therapist Emma Kenny gives her tips on easing the symptoms of depression

DON'T ISOLATE YOURSELF

It can take a huge amount of effort to socialise when you're feeling low, but the truth is that you need to stay connected. Call a friend when you're feeling particularly down, or pop over to their house for a coffee. Chances are you will feel better for it afterwards.

STRETCH YOUR LEGS

Studies have shown that people who live close to green space have lower rates of depression, anxiety and poor physical

health. Going for a walk in a local park and getting some fresh air will really help if you're feeling low. Try to make this a daily habit if you can – even if it's just for ten minutes.

FIND A FURRY FRIEND

Being around animals is proven to boost your mood, and many people suffering with depression find that having a pet helps them immensely. Ask to join your friend on their dog walk or volunteer to cat-sit.

LISTEN TO MUSIC

Playing an upbeat song can really improve your mood. Make a playlist of uplifting, fun songs for when you need a boost.

EAT WELL

Research shows that eating nonprocessed healthy food, full of leafy greens rich in nutrients, can help to balance mood and ensure that even when you

are struggling mentally, your body is being looked after physically.



When you're feeling low, there's an overwhelming tendency to focus on the negative aspects of life. Instead, take five minutes out of your day to sit down and focus on everything that went well and how it made you feel. It will incite feelings of positivity.





'THERE IS SO MUCH SUPPORT AVAILABLE FROM YOUR GP'

Dr Sarah Jarvis, clinical director at Patient. co.uk, says: "You should never be afraid to bring up depression with your GP as there is so much support available. Be brave and get it off your chest – the sooner you admit to having a problem, the sooner you'll get better. Your doctor will understand your symptoms and you can always bring a friend or family member if you think it would help. You may be asked to complete a patient health questionnaire or undergo a telephone interview, which helps your GP understand the severity of your depression. You'll then

be referred to IAPT (Improving Access to Psychological Therapies), where they decide what services are best for you. Sometimes this might be counselling sessions, a self-help group, or even cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT). CBT is a talking therapy and a powerful tool in beating your negative thoughts. In some cases, it's just as effective, if not more, than anti-depressants. I'd never recommend anti-depressants for people who have mild depression – but for more severe cases, anti-depressants are beneficial alongside therapy to amplify the benefits."

DENISE:

'My depression was so severe, but I'm learning to control it'

She's battled years of mental health problems, but Denise Welch is now keen to make the topic less taboo in a bid to help others

enise Welch has always been open about her ongoing battle with depression. The TV star suffered with postnatal depression after the birth of her son Matthew in 1989, which

developed into a more severe condition. Denise previously admitted she wanted to throw herself out of a moving car to "stop the pain in her head."

The star, 58, describes her disease as "like a black cloud had descended on my world from which I could see no way out." She previously told Closer: "My depression first hit me 28 years ago after the birth of my first son Matthew. It started out as postnatal depression and became so severe that I was verging on psychosis."

Denise has struggled with the illness ever since, although she's learnt techniques to control it. She's also battled alcoholism, and admits she used to turn to drink to self-medicate her condition.

"I used to drink to make myself feel better and the episode of depression would last three times as long," she says. "I was on a downward spiral - it's the most isolating condition."

MUCH HAPPIER

and Matthew

Denise - who's also mum to Louis, 16 - was eventually diagnosed with depression linked to a hormonal deficiency and was prescribed (female sex hormone)

> oestrogel. She reveals that taking the drug along with anti-depressants and cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) sessions,



as well as giving up alcohol, helps her manage her condition.

"I feel so much happier now; I don't fear depression like I used to," says Denise, "I'm putting some goodness back in. Of course I can't eradicate my depression completely - I can just wake up or be mid-conversation and it's there - but it's less frequent now."

BEING KINDER

And Denise - who is married to artist Lincoln Townley, 44, who also battled alcoholism in the past - says one of the main reasons she feels better these days is because she's kinder to herself.

"I treat myself with

tender loving care now," she says. "I used to force myself to go out, even when I was feeling really bad, because I didn't want to let people down. But Lincoln says to me: 'If you were vomiting, you'd be phoning people saying you can't make it and this is no different.' So now I will say: 'I'm having a few days off' and everyone understands."

And Denise is delighted that more celebs are breaking the taboo and talking publicly about depression.

"I never kept my depression a secret. When I started to see the light at the end of the tunnel, I was approached by a paper to speak about it. I was advised by some not to for fear it would damage my career, but it was fantastic that something positive could come out of the hell I'd been through.

"If you're suffering and you see someone speaking out about it, it's like a lifeline. It shows there is hope and that your depression doesn't define you." By Annabelle Lee

"I have to be careful about what jobs I take because I don't want to give myself unwanted pressure. I try not to put myself in a position where I get too stressed."

TAKE TIME TO RELAX

"I have to stay active to keep my illness at bay. Yoga and meditation ensure I feel healthy."

'I wasted years hating my body'

Giovanna Fletcher opens up to Closer about parenthood, her post-baby figure and *that* wedding video...

he's won thousands of online followers as a vlogger, with her refreshingly downto-earth attitude towards parenting. And Giovanna

Fletcher, who's married to McFly's Tom, and is mum to sons Buzz, two, and Buddy, one, is always brutally honest about her life.

In fact, last week, she bravely revealed she'd suffered a heartbreaking miscarriage before falling pregnant with Buzz, in a bid to help other women understand and talk about it more.

The 32-year-old author admitted she'd been diagnosed with Polycystic Ovary Syndrome [PCOS] and worried she would struggle to become a mother. But she fell pregnant shortly after getting married — with the help of fertility drugs — only to tragically miscarry just a few days later.

She revealed: "Anyone who has experienced that moment of knowing you're bleeding knows the paralysing horror that comes with it. When I found out, I wanted to scream at the world. I felt like I'd completely failed us. I might have only known I'd been pregnant for a couple of days but I'd carried around hopes of being a mother for decades. The thought of never being able to hold that baby in my arms was crushing. Miscarriage is awful, but it happens, and I still feel mournful. But I also feel lucky that I've gone on to have two healthy babies."

POST-BABY BODY

Fast-forward four years and Giovanna now has two young boys – and admits that life is hectic but extremely happy.

"It's busy at home!" she laughs. "Buzz is coming out of the terrible twos and he's learning to share, but I've heard about 'threenager' being the next thing, which will be interesting. But the boys are so sweet together, it melts my heart watching them.

I remember someone saying to me: 'You think you love your child but wait until you have another. Seeing them together is just a whole other thing.' She was right, it's just amazing."

And Giovanna – whose younger brother Mario is reportedly set to return to *TOWIE* – is equally as honest when it comes to her post-baby body. She posted a selfie a year ago, shortly after having Buddy, to encourage women not to feel under pressure to snap back into shape. This followed insensitive comments from a stranger about how she still had a mum-tum – just eleven days after giving birth. The picture went viral and soon racked up over 75,000 likes.

"I wasn't prepared for the response to that post. It felt like something I wanted to share to help other women feeling the same," she explains. "The more we get that message out there the better. We're always told our bodies should look a certain way and after you've had a baby it's harder than ever to look that way. I've got a nice little pouch on my tummy now!"

Giovanna admits her body will never be the same, but says it was a small sacrifice to pay.

"I look at my body and think, 'Yes, I'm a bit wobbly'. I've got stretch marks and leaky


boobs but I also have two children and my body has done that. Before I had children, I spent decades knocking my body, hating every single thing that would be seen as a flaw. Looking back I realise my body's not flawed, it's just the human body."

UP YOUR VITAMIN D TO BE COLD-FREE!

Boosting your vitamin D intake could help you avoid getting ill. Here's how...

new UK study that leafed through 25 pieces of research found that getting enough vitamin D could protect us against colds and flu by boosting immunity.

Vitamin D is known as the "sunshine vitamin" as we make it when our bare skin is exposed to the sun's rays. However, long, dark winters mean more than half of us in the UK don't get enough of the vitamin from October to April. Upping your vitamin D intake with your diet and with a supplement could be the answer.

"The body makes around 90 per cent of the vitamin D it needs, but this can only happen when your skin gets enough direct UV light from the sun," says Elizabeth Wall, Nutritionist at Holland & Barrett. "The other 10 per cent comes from food, but most of us don't eat enough

of the foods rich in it, such as oily fish and egg yolks. Look for cereals, milk and juices fortified with vitamin D, too, and take a good-quality daily supplement with 10mcg. Try Fultium Daily D3 [£3.99 for 30 capsules, Hollandandbarrett.com]."

Research also links lack of vitamin D with an increased risk of diabetes, depression, musculoskeletal disorders, weight gain, heart disease and cancer, so there are plenty of reasons to up your intake. We need 400iu (international units) – or 10mcg – of vitamin D every day.

While taking too much over a long time can mean your body absorbs too much calcium – which can weaken bones and damage your kidneys and the heart – a 10mcg daily dose won't do that, so worry not.

Here is Elizabeth's pick of the best vitamin D-rich foods to add to your weekly shop.

CANNED TONA

Oily fish is a great source of vitamin D – and canned tuna has around 236iu of vitamin D per 100g (over half the minimum recommended daily intake). It's convenient and versatile and less pricey than fresh fish. Other good choices include wild salmon, trout, sole, pilchards, sardines, mackerel, halibut and herring (canned or fresh).



MUSHROOMS

Mushrooms, like humans, synthesise vitamin D when exposed to UV light, so they're a great source.
Good choices include button, wild, portobello and shiitake mushrooms.
A 3oz serving of portobello mushrooms, or 4-5 cheshnut mushrooms, gives you 400iu - your recommended daily intake.



TOFU

Tofu is an excellent source of vitamin D and is high in protein, magnesium, selenium, zinc, calcium, iron, phosphorus and vitamin B1, too. 100g firm tofu contains around 130iu. Always drain well before cooking. Marinate in soy sauce and use in stir-fries, in place of meat in curries, or serve in Mexican-style tortillas.



ALMOND MILK

Most almond milks are fortified with vitamin D, so 200ml has around 90iu as well as calcium, magnesium, phosphorus, zinc and vitamins A, C and E. It's lower in calories than cows' milk, too. Choose unsweetened and blend 200ml with a banana, a dash of vanilla essence and a sprinkle of nutmed for a quick, tasty smoothie.



WHOLEGRAIN CEREALS

Many breakfast cereals and instant oats are fortified with vitamins and minerals, including vitamin D. An average 30g serving will provide around 100iu (just under a quarter of your recommended daily intake), but most of us pour much bigger portions than 30g. Check the label for the exact amount per serving and have with almond milk and berries.



STEP1 Crush 250g mixed berries (fresh or frozen) and mix with 120g low-fat cream cheese.

STEP 2 Place a pan over a medium heat and add the butter. When melted, tip in the lardons and cook for a few minutes, until the fat has rendered out and they're golden. Add the peas and salmon and stir over the heat for a minute or two, until the salmon starts to cook, then pour in the cream and boil, uncovered, for 2 minutes, until slightly thickened. Add the lemon juice, parsley and season to taste.

STEP 3 Tip the drained pasta into the sauce and mix, then serve.



We think they cure everything, but they don't touch certain illnesses, as Dr Christian explains

TOP THEET



I've changed my diet and cut out meat. I'm nauseous, tired and dizzy. Is it low iron levels?

DR CHRISTIAN: It's possible, but it could be a number of things, such as a vitamin D deficiency. Ask your GP for a blood test to find out more.

IN THE NEWS...

'EATING OUT IS FUELLING CHILDHOOD OBESITY'

Health officials have warned that dining out is now so commonplace, it's contributing to child obesity.

IN MY OPINION...



Apparently one in 10 children in the survey had eaten out at least six times in the previous week. It's now normal to eat out regularly, but it means you don't always know what is going into your food. Often,

kids' menus are the worst – all pizza, chicken nuggets and chips. Your kids won't choose chips if they don't eat that at home, so start your healthy habits there. And if the kids' menu is awful, ask for a smaller portion of something from the regular menu.

CLOSER ONLINE FOR MORE HEALTH NEWS, VISIT WWW.CLOSERONLINE.CO.UK/ HEALTH-AND-FITNESS here's one simple rule antibiotics only treat bacterial infections, not viral ones, so when you feel awful and ask for them, that's why we often say no, because they won't work! We're running out of antibiotics, and I see it every day. When I send samples to the lab, they grow the bug, then send me a list of antibiotics and tell me if they're "sensitive" or "resistant" to it. More and more, I get columns of "r" for resistant.

Antibiotics I used to prescribe don't exist any more. It's not just because GPs have overprescribed them, bacteria is becoming resistant to the drugs because people skip them, save them up for later and share them with friends. For example, if you take antibiotics for a few days, then feel better and stop taking them, you may not have killed off all the bacteria and the remaining bacteria develops a resistance. Here's my guide to when they do and don't work.

TREAT A COLD AT THE CHEMIST

Nasty colds, flu, sore throats and coughs are viral, so antibiotics won't help. Even if your cold or cough develops into sinusitis or bronchitis, if you're young, fit and generally well, you should shake it off without antibiotics. The shivery, feverish feeling should only last a few days at worst. If it goes on for longer and after

a week you're still feverish, having trouble swallowing or coughing up green gunk, call your surgery and ask for a GP to phone you, rather than going in. You often read that the colour of your snot tells you if you need antibiotics that's not true most colds give you green snot. Stay warm, take painkillers, rest, eat what you fancy and drink lots of fluids. The same applies for kids unless you have that mother's intuition that something's not right, look after your children at home.

SOOTHE SINUSITIS SYMPTOMS

You shouldn't need antibiotics for sinusitis where your nose gets blocked, you can get headaches, lose your sense of taste and you feel tenderness around your cheeks. People who regularly suffer with it know when they need antibiotics to clear it, but a young, healthy person who doesn't get it often can usually ride it out with over-the-counter products. Relieve symptoms with painkillers, decongestants and steam. Also, don't blow

your nose too hard, as it can make things worse.



VISIT YOUR GP FOR BAD BITES

It depends on what bite you have and how deep it is - human bites are the worst, so if your child has been bitten by another child, you probably should get an antibiotic. Animals

and humans have a lot of bacteria in their mouths, so if it's a nasty, deep bite it can get infected and that infection could spread if left untreated. The usual treatment for a small bite is to wash it carefully, remove any hairs or dirt, squeeze it to encourage it to bleed a little, then dress it and it should be fine. No doctor will be cross if you see them for a nasty bite, though.

TAKE PAINKILLERS TO SORT EAR INFECTIONS

Ear infections usually improve on their own, unless a baby of under a year has one, then you should take them to the doctor.

Otherwise, you can treat an ear infection using Calpol for a young child, and with paracetamol or ibuprofen for an adult, and it should clear in a few days. If there's lots of gunk coming out of the ear or the pain is unbearable after a few days, see your GP. If it's swimmer's ear

(infection of the outer ear as a result of trapped water) - often topical eardrops from the pharmacist will do, if not you can get something stronger prescribed. Try the pharmacy first and avoid getting water and shampoo in your ears when showering.

BUY DROPS FOR EYE INFECTIONS

Conjunctivitis, or "pink eye," is usually viral, especially if it's spread through work, school or the family. Don't rub or scratch your eyes, don't share towels, wash your hands regularly and use eye drops from the pharmacist. Don't go to the surgery as it's hugely contagious! Gently wash away the crusty bits and don't wear contacts. If it doesn't go, it's pouring thick green gunk or your vision is in any way compromised, see your doctor, who may prescribe you antibiotics, but if it's just a bit itchy and sore, treat it at home.

SEE YOUR GP FOR UTIS

If you get that urgent urge to pee, feel like you can't empty your bladder and you're getting tummy pain, drink lots of fluids and have some cranberry extract. But if you're getting fevers, you're in a lot of pain or it's going around the back, antibiotics are needed. You don't really get viral urinary tract infection, they tend to be bacterial. If you frequently have UTIs, avoid perfumed beauty products, stay hydrated, don't hold your pee, wipe front to back, and avoid tight, synthetic underwear. For children with UTI symptoms, see your GP right away.

IF YOU HAVE TO TAKE THEM...

Antibiotics wipe out all bugs, so they'll kill the good bacteria in your gut, too. That can lead to vaginal thrush or tummy troubles. After taking antibiotics, take probiotics. You want many types of bacteria, rather than millions of one type - or eat fermented foods like kefir.

'I'm stuck in low-paid jobs'

Shay McKenzie, 18, is unemployed and lives at her boyfriend's family home in east London



"I left school in 2015 and started a practical apprenticeship in business administration at a beauty salon. I was earning

£3.50 per hour as a receptionist, working 11 hours a day. The salon closed, but I went to a different salon on the same scheme, earning £5.50 per hour for seven hours a day. After three months I had a disagreement with my manager and was let go last summer. In both jobs I felt I was overworked and underpaid.

"In December I started as an administrator at an accountancy firm – again on the same scheme. But I left after a month because I felt I wasn't being paid enough. I'm now searching for work that isn't an apprenticeship. Ideally I'd like to go into beauty or retail and eventually own a business.

"My apprenticeship gave me a level 2 diploma in business administration and I have solid receptionist experience, which is what I usually search for when job hunting.

"I'm living rent-free at my boyfriend's family's house, but we can only stay here for so long. And although my boyfriend works as a stock taker, I want to be able to contribute. It's a struggle to get a job as I am still lacking in experience but I don't want to go back to another low-paid apprenticeship."

SARAH'S 3-POINT PLAN

1) Get a foot on the ladder

Lunderstand Shay's resentment, but she needs to take a job and stick at it. The short stints and gaps between jobs on her CV will make her look unreliable, so she needs to demonstrate that she will stay in a job. There are rules about minimum wage, even for apprentices. Those in their first vear must be paid £3.40 per hour and in the second year this rises to £5.55 for those aged 18 to 20. Away from apprenticeships, the national minimum wage for Shay's age group is £5.60 per hour. Getting experience in business is the most important thing, with or

without an apprenticeship. Shay should look for admin roles in industries she's interested in. Check Monster.co.uk and Reed.co.uk and local Facebook pages. Also, Cibtac.com and Cidesco.com run courses for the beauty industry and Habia. org has lots of advice too.

2) Top up with evening work Shay could work in the evenings in a bar or restaurant to supplement her income. Just check benefits to make sure that she can earn and claim.

3) Save earnings Shay has very low outgoings, so once she's earning she should put money aside as a buffer for rent. She admits that living with her boyfriend's family is short-term so she should aim to save three months' salary as a backup.

- BE OPEN. If you have lots of platonic male friends, tell your new man about them to prevent him feeling excluded or jealous.


IS SURGERY THE RIGHT CHOICE?





We hear there's a lot more banter a bit like when original hosts Jeremy Clarkson, James May and Richard Hammond did the show?


What people forget is, it took them a while to build up a rapport. This is the first season for the three of us, but we are starting to click now. We are having lots of fun.

it is. It's those guys; they are great.


