

MAN CREATES DATING APP. DOESN'T LET OTHER MEN JOIN



Tom Cruise has a change of heart about his relationship with **Suri** following the death of his mother

t was a devastating loss for Tom Cruise. In early February, his beloved mother, Mary Lee South, died in her sleep at age 80. Over the weekend of Feb. 11, Tom gathered with his three sisters to honor their mom at a memorial service near Scientology headquarters in Clearwater, Fla. "Having his mother pass away like this and then attending a family funeral for her," says a close friend, "made Tom re-evaluate what's most important in his life."

At the top of the list? His relationship with his daughter Suri. The fifth-grader, who turns 11 in April, was 7 the last time Tom, 54, was publicly photographed with her. On Sept. 15, 2013, a year after Katie Holmes, 38, blindsided him with divorce papers, Tom and Suri were spotted together at a mini-golf range in New York's Adirondack Mountains. "Mary Lee's death really turned Tom's head around," says the close friend. "Tom now wants to re-establish his relationship with his daughter and begin seeing her on a regular basis."

He knows reconnecting won't be easy. "Tom realizes that he has an incredible amount of time to make up with Suri, but he's willing to do what it takes," says the friend. Adds a source: "Tom knows that she won't just go jumping back into his arms, and that he's going to have to take it slow and steady to show her

he's back in her life for good."

Tom is about to drop the bombshell on Katie. "He's going to get word to her through their handlers and attorneys that he wants to see Suri within the next few weeks," says the friend. "He's already in preproduction on *Mission: Impossible 6* and wants to reconnect with Suri before he throws himself into making the big action film."

Tom's intense work schedule has long been blamed for why he doesn't see his little girl. "He always uses filming commitments as his excuse," says the source. Adds the friend, "Tom has built his life in a way where he goes almost immediately from one movie to the next, but he's now willing to make time for Suri."

Another possible reason he hasn't seen her: Scientology. Multiple insiders have told In Touch that after his divorce from Katie, Tom's religion declared her a "suppressive person," the term that's applied to people the church perceives as enemies. "Tom is disconnected from Katie, and then from Suri because of her connection to Katie," an insider previously explained. But Tom, says the friend, "is such a deified figure in the church that he can bend Scientology rules to his benefit. In other words, if he wants to see Suri, he can."



And now, finally, he will. "It's been a long time since she's had Tom physically in her life," the source says of Suri. "But Tom's ready to ramp up his relationship with her in a big way." Adds the friend, "He was so moved by Mary Lee's funeral and the importance of family that he's made up his mind: He doesn't want to lose out on any more time with Suri."

Outspoken former Scientologist Leah Remini has made bold new claims about Tom and the power he wields within the church. During a Feb. 17 appearance on HBO's Real Time With Bill Maher, Leah claimed that hard-line rules other Scientologists are required to follow to the letter are "bent for him," adding that it's "part of the hypocrisy" of the church. She also agreed with her host's suggestion that Tom could single-handedly shut down the religion, which she claims is rife with abusive practices, if he wanted to. "He could end this," she said. When Leah – who just wrapped the first season of her A&E docuseries, Scientology and the Aftermath – added that the church is pushing the idea that Tom is "changing the planet" because of his success, Maher quipped, "Changing the planet? Is Kanye Headed fo Another Breakdown

Three months after his mental-health crisis, loved ones are terrified **Kanye West** isn't getting better

he scene was downright sedate. In stark contrast to the chaotic, over-thetop atmosphere that has come to define Kanye West's fashion shows, the rapper's Season 5 presentation at NYC's Pier 59 Studios on Feb. 15 started a fashionable 20 minutes late and went on for just 13 minutes, accompanied by an old song by The-Dream. "In the context of Kanye," noted The New York Times, "the effect was tame." Hidden away backstage, the usually bombastic and ego-driven star didn't even come out onto the runway to take a traditional designer's bow.

He's not ready to be back in the spotlight. Three months after Kanye suffered a devastating mental breakdown that saw him handcuffed to a gurney and hospitalized for eight days, In Touch has learned he's struggling mightily to cope. "Kanye is most definitely not himself right now. He gets overwhelmed by being around a lot of people, especially in situations he doesn't want to be in," a Kanye source tells In Touch exclusively. Those close to him fear he could be headed for another breakdown. "Kanye is struggling to get better," says an insider, "and [wife] Kim [Kardashian] and his team don't want people to know how fragile he really is."

Kanye's condition is serious. While his exact diagnosis remains the subject of speculation, sources

have told *In Touch* that his mental health must be strictly managed with medication. "Right now, it's all about taking baby steps with Kanye," says the insider. "Those who love him want him to move forward, not backward." It's been an enormous challenge. "He doesn't trust most people, and he goes through these times when he is sullen and depressed or manic and erratic," says the Kanye source. "Right now, I'd say he's depressed. He just seems unhappy. His personality is just not there. He's very isolated."

Kanye's decision to skip the Grammys on Feb. 12 spoke volumes about his condition. "It wasn't some political statement about protesting the awards' relevance like everyone wants you to believe. Kim and his team urged Kanye not to attend because he's still really struggling with his mental state," says the

insider. Recording Academy president Neil Portnow even publicly hinted at this, revealing after the telecast that Kanve, who was nominated for eight awards, had been in talks to perform but bowed out because he "had

some medical concerns and situations." For Kanye, explains the insider, "attending the Grammys would have been like pouring gasoline on fire. It would have made an already bad situation far worse."

There was a real fear that Kanye could have had another on-air meltdown. "He surely would have been upset and reacted when Beyoncé lost out to Adele for Album of the Year," says the insider. "His team was all about avoiding another Taylor Swift incident" (he grabbed the singer's mic at the 2009 MTV Video Music Awards to protest her victory over Beyoncé). Considering what he's going through, they're confident they made the right call. "Right now," says the insider, "it's all about Kanye getting better and avoiding any public events that might trigger a negative reaction."

His Fashion Show Was a Flop

The fashion elite didn't exactly go wild for Kanye's Season 5 Yeezy clothes. "The collection didn't feel startling or new," The Cut's Véronique Hyland wrote of the denim ensembles (pictured), baggy tracksuits, sweatshirts and, of course, Kanye's trademark Yeezy sneakers. W magazine deemed the line "perfect for a quick dash to Starbucks" and The New York Times simply called it "deflated."






Angelina Jolie's bid to keep Brad Pitt from his kids blows up in her face

ngelina Jolie chose her words carefully. In her first interview since her bitter September split from Brad Pitt, she insisted, "I don't want to say very much" about what led her to end their marriage - then proceeded to say an awful lot. "Many, many people find themselves in this situation. My whole, my family...we've all being through a difficult time. My focus is my children, our children...and my focus is finding this way through," she told the BBC while in Cambodia for the Feb. 18 premiere of her latest directorial effort, First They Killed My Father. "We are and forever will be a family. I am coping with finding a way through to make sure that this somehow makes us stronger and closer."

But she was hiding the real story: Her war with Brad is nastier than ever. Five months after she blindsided him with the divorce and launched a


They can count on it. But Angelina isn't making it easy on him. "Angie and Brad still aren't even talking," says the source. "Brad has made numerous attempts to get a healthy dialogue going, to no avail." So Angelina's speech about wanting to unite the family doesn't ring true based on her previous actions. Hollywood has sided with Brad, giving him a roaring ovation at the Golden Globes, a clear anti-Angelina message. What's more, Angie is busy trying to rehab her public image. One of her key handlers has been calling various media outlets looking for positive coverage of Angie since the divorce debacle, according to the New York Post.

Desperate to get on the same page with Angie for the kids' sake, Brad suggested a family reunion at Chateau Miraval. The sprawling estate in France has served as their European base for years (see sidebar on next page). But Angelina refused. "Brad told Angie's camp that he wanted her to join him in France at their estate with their six kids for a few weeks this summer," says the source, "but Angie's camp told Brad she has no desire to go back to Miraval." Undeterred, Brad tried a new approach. "He asked Angie's camp to choose a location for the family to vacation this summer and said he would pay for the entire trip," says the source. She said no to that, too. "Angie has absolutely no interest in co-parenting the kids with Brad. She just isn't ready to go down that road yet."

In her new interview, Angelina tried to present an image of herself as an everymom facing a tough divorce. But in reality, after spending the past several months attacking Brad in court papers and in the press, she's now digging in the knife again, publicly stressing how she wants to keep the family together — even though she's the one who tore it apart — and painting a false picture of an idyllic home life with the kids. "Right now, I'm going through a moment when just everybody's in my

ruthless bid for sole custody of their six kids - saying it was "for the health of the family" - Angelina has lost, and she's humiliated. "Angie gave up her bid for sole custody when her legal team told her there were just no grounds for it," the source tells In Touch exclusively. The couple has reached a secret settlement. "Brad has won and is getting shared custody." Angelina, 41, has been forced to accept that after intense, lengthy child abuse investigations by both the LA Department of Children and Family Services and the FBI cleared Brad, 53, of any wrongdoing, there was no way any judge would sign off on giving her sole custody. "There is just no basis for Brad to not have the kids at least half of the time. The weeklong visits Brad has requested are going to be happening very soon as their lawyers work out the particulars with a private judge."

Brad's been waiting for this moment. During an overnight visit in early February with his four youngest kids at his compound in LA's Los Feliz neighborhood, he made sure Zahara, 12, Shiloh, 10, and twins Knox and Vivienne, 8, had plenty to do — and had a blast. "The kids were very excited to spend the night with Brad," the source tells In Touch, explaining that by day, they spent hours riding bikes around the property and gated community together, and by night, they made s'mores in an outdoor fire pit. "Knox and Shiloh asked when they could they visit their Santa Barbara house, since there are motorbikes to ride there," adds the source. "While Brad has been very careful to not make any prom-



room: two dogs, two hamsters and two children at the moment. It's wonderful," she told the BBC of adjusting to a new normal. "But usually, I just wake up trying to figure out who's going to get [the] dog out, who's going to start the pancakes and did anybody brush their teeth." (One problem: Angelina doesn't even cook, insiders have previously told In Touch - and that includes pancakes.)

While Brad keeps going out of his way to make things work with her, she keeps bucking his suggestions. He even gave her the green light to take all six kids to Cambodia with her as she launched her Netflix movie about the Cambodian genocide - one that Cambodia native Maddox, 15, and Vietnam-born Pax, 13, also worked on last year (see sidebar). "Angie needs Brad's approval to take the kids out of the country," explains the source. "Brad's open to

Angie taking the kids abroad, but he wants to be able to still have visitation with them during those times." Angelina shot that down, too. Says the source: "She's just adamant that Brad not have access to the kids while

they're out of the country."

She's convinced herself that Brad is battling some dark demons. "She still believes he has a problem with alcohol," says the source. Their relationship blew apart when, on a private flight from France

to the States on Sept. 14, a drunken Brad argued with Angelina and got physical with Maddox and Pax. The episode led an anonymous caller to alert DCFS, and Angelina filed for divorce days later. But during the DCFS inquiry, which lasted for months, Brad was cleared of abuse charges and "all of Brad's random drug tests came back negative," says the source. "And Brad insists he doesn't abuse alcohol."

Brad's still working on his relationship with Maddox and Pax. "The four younger kids have continued to have overnight visits with Brad, but Maddox and Pax have not," says the source. "They're refusing to go to Brad's house overnight because of lingering feelings of anger and resentment toward him." The entire family has been in therapy for months now, and Brad's taken a slowand-steady approach to mending his relationship with his oldest sons. "Brad is going to be making moves in the next few months to establish a new relationship with Maddox and Pax. He will work with the therapist to make this happen and only wants the boys to be back in his life on the healthiest grounds possible," explains the source. "He feels Angie has done a great disservice to both of the boys because Maddox and Pax feel as if they have to protect her."

How the kids should be educated also remains a huge bone of contention between Brad and Angelina. "It's a huge roadblock in the talks between their lawyers," says the source. Brad is insisting the kids enroll in a traditional school in LA, while Angelina wants them to continue to be homeschooled. "The private judge might be forced to decide how the kids will be educated."

Brad is desperate for the turmoil to end. "Being in counseling has been tremendously helpful for him and has helped him to work through the anger over the divorce and custody battle," says the source. "He's ready to move on from all of the nastiness. Now Angelina just has to do her part."



"I wanted to focus not just on the war but on the love of family," Angelina said of her new movie.

Justin Bieber lashes out as The Weeknd flaunts his romance with Selena Gomez

is message was hard to miss. A month after going public with his romance with Selena Gomez, The Weeknd was featured on an explicit new song, "Some Way," released by rapper Nav on Feb. 15 about stealing a woman from her boyfriend: "I think your girl, think your girl fell in love with me / She say my f---, and my tongue game a remedy." Many fans immediately interpreted the lyrics as a direct diss of Selena's first love and perpetual on/off ex, Justin Bieber.

Justin heard it that way, too. "He freaked out," an insider tells *In Touch*, and lashed out at The Weeknd (real name: Abel Tesfaye). "He left a voicemail on Selena's phone, and he knew she would have Abel listen to it. In it, Justin told him to 'watch out' because he was going to drop a song that was 'more real than anything you've ever heard' if Abel didn't back down." The Weeknd isn't doing anything of the sort — and now, says a source, "Justin and Abel are at war."

Justin had already been spiraling. "He called Selena several times in mid-February," says the insider. "She told friends he seems to have snapped." He did: Multiple sources tell In Touch that on Feb. 10, Justin, 22, got into at least four fights - with two male patrons, a bartender and his pal, actor Kyle Massey - while partying at LA hot spot Serafina. "Justin was very drunk and demanding more drinks. He was fighting," explains one eyewitness. Adds a second eyewitness: "He was drinking tequila all night. He was out of control." A third eyewitness says the pop star should be embarrassed: "They had to pull Justin off the bartender. It was horrendous." (Two days earlier, Justin missed a deposition in a legal battle over his hit song "Sorry." He claimed he was sick but hours later posted photos on Instagram of himself drinking with friends; videos surfaced on YouTube that same day of him chugging beers with Kyle at a house party.)

Selena's increasingly public romance with The Weeknd "has hit a nerve," says the source. Last month, when Justin was asked on-camera about his fellow Canadian artist's music, he replied, "Hell no, I can't listen to a Weeknd song. That s---'s wack." In a live Instagram Q&A on Feb. 12, Justin said his favorite

song right now is The Weeknd's hit "Starboy" before dissolving into a 15-second fit of childish laughter and ending the chat.

Justin's animosity is driven by his loneliness and enduring feelings for Selena. Two days after the Instagram slam, he posted — then deleted — two videos lamenting his lack of a valentine. "He always thought Selena would carry a torch for him," adds the source, "but she's refusing to be manipulated by him anymore." In fact, Selena piled on the misery Feb. 16 when she released a scathing new song, "It Ain't Me," which fans took as a tell-all about her toxic relationship with Justin ("We stopped seeing eye to eye / You were staying out all night / And I had enough"). "Justin," says the source, "went ballistic."

It's only going to get worse. According to the insider, Justin has learned that The Weeknd and Selena are collaborating on a song that will bash him further. "Justin's friends are worried that all hell will break loose if he comes face-to-face with The Weeknd," says the source, noting that Justin and Orlando Bloom once got physical over Miranda Kerr. "History could easily repeat itself with The Weeknd if they end up in the same room!"



The Weeknd's ex Bella Hadid, 20, opened up to *Teen Vogue* about her former love of nearly two years, confessing that despite their October breakup, "I'll always love him." When Selena read it, "She was furious," says an insider. "Selena hates that Bella's talking about Abel. She says it's because Bella needs to feel relevant." The truth, says the insider, is that "Bella's comments make Selena nervous. She wants to believe she's good enough, but Bella's a gorgeous supermodel – Selena worries Abel could go back to her."

Rehab, abuse charges and a war over millions of dollars shatter Lisa Marie Presley

er claims were deeply troubling. In new court documents filed in her ongoing divorce battle with fourth husband Michael Lockwood, Lisa Marie Presley dropped bombshell after bombshell. Elvis' only child revealed that she's in massive debt and that the couple's 8-year-old twin girls, Finley and Harper, were removed from their home by child protective services. The officials acted around the time Lisa Marie discovered "hundreds of inappropriate photos" of children as well as "disturbing video footage" on Michael's computer that left her "shocked and horrified and sick to my stomach," she charged in court papers, claiming Michael had at least 80 devices. Beverly Hills police raided her home, took several items and then turned the potential case over to Tennessee authorities.

Behind the scenes, the drama is even more shocking. "This could very well be one of the ugliest divorces Hollywood has ever seen," says an insider, as the former couple battles over their postnuptial agreement and prepares to face off in family court in March. In Touch has learned new information about Lisa Marie's rehab stint last year and who

is taking care of her daughters and why. "The claims she made about Michael totally backfired because [LA County's De-

partment of Children and Family Services] was forced to investigate both parents and ended up taking the kids away from both," says the insider. "Lisa Marie is having a total meltdown."

She's been struggling for months. Lisa Marie revealed in court papers that she'd spent time in treatment and was living with her actress daughter Riley Keough, 27, while her twins were under the care of DCFS. Now the twins are living with her mom Priscilla, 71. "Lisa Marie had to check her-

self into rehab [for three months last fall]," the insider says of the 49-yearold, who has been open about battling drinking and drug addiction. "She's had issues with substance abuse, pills and booze, and that could be why [DCFS] removed the girls from her care. It's definitely why she was in rehab - she's

The drama is about to get worse. In legal papers, Lisa Marie claims that the couple's March court date is "regarding allegations of sexual abuse and neglect" against Michael, 55, and that he's also under police investigation. His attorney vehemently denies any wrongdoing on Michael's part. Another lawyer for Michael says there are also allegations against Lisa Marie. Meanwhile, the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation stated it is still trying to figure out if a crime was committed on its turf (the couple lived in Franklin, Tenn., for two years) and had "not opened an official case in connection to this matter."

The couple is also battling over money. Michael, a musician, is asking for \$40,000 a month in spousal support. Lisa Marie insists she doesn't have to pay that, according to the terms of a postnuptial agreement they signed a year after their 2006 wedding. Lisa is also claiming her only monthly income - aside from a \$4,361-a-month paycheck she earns from Graceland - is \$100,000 she draws monthly from the Elvis estate, which is deposited in a trust. She also claims she owes millions in back taxes. Michael maintains she's lying about her finances. Says the insider: "There's definitely a lot at stake here."

But the damage has been done. "The family has been ripped apart," says the insider. "Lisa Marie opened up this Pandora's box, and there's no closing it now."
