

When former Today co-host Tamron Hall, 46, left NBC on Feb. 1, there were whispers ABC would snatch her up. But there's at least one person at the network who isn't exactly keen on the idea: Kelly Ripa. 



3 Months After His Breakdown, KANYE'S STILL STRUGGLING

fter Kanye West skipped the Grammys in LA despite his eight nominations, his mother-in-law, Kris Jenner, explained it was because he had to be in NYC for his New York Fashion Week show three days later. But an insider exclusively tells *Life & Style* that the real reason Kanye, 39, was a no-show is that he's still struggling with mental health issues three months after his November 2016 breakdown and subsequent hospitalization at UCLA Medical Center. His team, including wife Kim Kardashian, "didn't feel Kanye was ready to attend the Grammys," says the insider. Recording Academy president Neil Portnow confirmed that "medical concerns" kept Kanye from appearing. "At the end of the day," Portnow said, "what we had heard was he just wasn't in a place where he felt comfortable [performing]." Kanye also didn't do a traditional bow at the end of his own Yeezy Season 5 fashion show in NYC on Feb. 15. "Right now, it's all about Kanye getting better and avoiding any public events that might trigger a negative reaction," says the insider, while a second source confirms that the rapper is recovering at a slow pace: "Kanye is definitely not himself right now." W

Polygamist Kody Brown's only legal wife, Robyn, is done with her husband's increasingly bad behavior

he skies were gray and stormy, but nothing was going to stop Kody Brown from marching on the Utah State Capitol in Salt Lake City on Feb. 10. His hair drenched by the rain, the *Sister Wives* star joined a

crowd of roughly 200 people to protest a bill that would keep polygamy a felony (punishable by up to five years in prison) in his former home state. By his side were spiritual wives Christine. Meri and Janelle, who held a sign that read, "Keep the government out of our bedrooms." But Kody's only legal wife, Robyn, was nowhere to be found.

She's had enough of polygamy — and her husband. Fed

up with her crumbling marriage and miserable life with Kody, Robyn, 38 — who for years enjoyed her status as his favorite wife — is done. Kody's heavy drinking, erratic behav-

ior and decision to cut Robyn off financially have pushed her to the brink. But what finally sent her over the edge: the 24-yearold Montana woman Kody, 49, has lined up to be his new wife as part of his effort to save the clan's struggling TLC show. "She's always said that if he takes on new wives, she'll leave," Robyn's best friend Kendra Pollard tells Life & Style. Now things have gotten so bad in Robyn and Kody's house of horrors that pals expect a divorce announcement any day now. "Robyn has told friends she is going to divorce Kody," Kendra exclusively tells *Life & Style*. "She believes it is her only choice. She says he will be getting a rude awakening soon when he's served with papers."

SO MUCH DRAMA

This wouldn't be Robyn's first time walking away from a bad relationship. She divorced first husband David Preston Jessop in 2008 after nine years of marriage. "Robyn isn't like the other sister wives. She is a strong person who values her independence," says Kendra. And Robyn can no longer tolerate Kody's bad behavior. "He is spiraling out of control," says Kendra, who has appeared on *Sister Wives* with the family. "She can no longer trust him. Robyn told me how Kody is drinking a lot of alcohol [these

days]. He is becoming a hothead, he has no filter and it is freaking Robyn out." As Robyn and Kody's relationship crumbled, "they would fight and yell at each other," says Kendra. "Now Robyn simply ignores him, which makes him even more infuriated." While their clashes never turned physical, Kody "has a nasty tongue on him," adds Kendra. "Robyn told me how Kody said to her, 'You would not have any of this if it wasn't for me.' Kody has to be the king of his castle."

Now the king wants a new, younger queen. "Kody met her through one of his friends a couple of years ago," Kendra says of the 24-year-old, who will move from Montana to Las Vegas to join the family. "She's a wild thing and she thinks Kody is hot. She said to him, 'Let me know if you ever want a hot, young wife.' Now Kody is taking her up on the offer."

MONEY PROBLEMS

But according to Kendra, he can barely afford to support the wives he's already got. By November 2016, Kody had racked up a six-figure debt, she reveals. Even so, he's fixated on Robyn's troubled finances. "Robyn has nothing, and Kody sees her as a financial burden," says Kendra. "She wanted Kody to reinvest in her business, My Sisterwife's Closet, but he refuses to give her any more money because he thinks it isn't making enough of a profit. Robyn never thought he could be so selfish."

In the past, Kody had reserved his worst treatment for Meri. In 2014, after being legally wed to her for 24 years, Kody pushed her aside to marry Robyn and adopt her three kids from her previous relationship. Downgraded to a nonlegal spiritual wife, hurt Meri sought comfort in an online affair with a man who famously turned

out to be a female catfisher. Kody publicly claims to have forgiven Meri, but Kendra says there's still drama behind closed doors. "Before he goes to see Meri, Kody has to have at least a glass of wine just so he can put up with her," Kendra says.

Kody is running out of allies in his own home. He's recently begun favoring Janelle, whom he had treated poorly for years — including fat-shaming her in front of the rest of the family and frequently reducing her to tears. According to Kendra, she's "his No. 1 wife now." "Janelle is making money through her fitness company, Strive With Janelle, and when Kody visits her, she sits and shuts up. He likes that. She's solid and she makes him feel adored," Kendra says. "Robyn used to be the love of his life, but now he sees her as a whiner. All she does is upset him."

LOOKING OUT FOR HIMSELF


With the future of Sister Wives up in the air, Kody is desperately looking for a new source of cash and fame. And he's willing to ditch all of his wives in the process. "Kody pitched the idea of a 'brother husband' show to TLC, based around a group of polygamous men giving one another advice," reveals Kendra. "But the network did not want to turn it into a series." (TLC aired an unrelated special called Brother Husbands about a woman with two husbands, on Feb. 5.) Kody now wants to pitch the show to Bravo's Andy Cohen, Kendra says. "Kody has met Andy before," she notes, "and Kody says Andy is fascinated with the male perspective on polygamy."

Robyn wants nothing to do with Kody or any of his future plans. While she's still under contract with Sister Wives for now, she's counting the days until she's free. "Robyn would love to pack her bags, fill up a truck with her things and head over to her family in Utah," says Kendra, adding that Robyn is done with living a lie. "She is going to leave Kody hanging in the wind," Kendra says, "as she pursues a fresh life." 🐼



In 2015, lonely Meri engaged in a six-month emotional affair with an online stranger, someone she believed to be a man named Sam Cooper. Her love interest was really a female con artist named Jackie Overton, though, and she later released (under Sam's name) the explosive tell-all Almost Meri'ed, revealing secrets Meri told her — including that she "went mute for several years" because of Kody's constant berating. Provocative photos she'd sent to "Sam" (like one of her suggestively eating a banana) were also published. Meri thought she'd put the ordeal behind her, but she was wrong. "There is still a big problem that she faces," family friend Kendra Pollard tells *Life & Style*. "The person who catfished her claims to have compromising photos of Meri in the bathtub that 'Sam' recorded during a FaceTime conversation." If the claim is true, the leak of humiliating new pics could destroy the Brown clan completely. "The family still feels like Meri is not being honest, and that's causing problems," says an insider. "The whole thing is a train wreck."





hold a small spiritual ceremony on the other side of the world. "Miley has a real hippie side and wants to embrace that rather than spending millions," an insider reveals. "She wants to focus on the spiritual side of marriage and is very interested in Hinduism, so she is looking at locations in Nepal, where Hinduism is a way of life."

BLENDING TRADITIONS

Low-key Liam is happy to let his bride call the shots. So the wedding's shaping up to be a very Miley affair. It'll take place over several days, the insider says, with multiple events including meditation, yoga, prayers, elephant rides, guitar playing, dancing and sleeping under the

stars. "In true Miley style, the wedding will be bright and colorful, with flower petals and brightly colored hearts and circles hanging from the trees," the insider says. "Being an animal lover, Miley wants to be surrounded by elephants, horses, peacocks and doves on her big day." And forget filet mignon and caviar: The food will be simple vegan fare (think rice, mushrooms, tofu and vegan pizza).







DIETS THAT WORK

How Sofía Vergara Reached Her Wedding Weight:

(Produce + Protein)

ithout question, Sofía Vergara from Modern Family has one of the most enviable bodies on the big or small screen. Still, the actress-model-perfume creator wanted to slim down on a tight timetable before her wedding to True Blood and Magic Mike actor Joe Manganiello in 2015 - and she did. Sofía, now 44, lost a quick 10 pounds by consuming a healthy, balanced diet that emphasized fresh fruit, vegetables and lean protein and minimized starchy carbs. She ate small, frequent meals that added up to 1,200 calories per day. Her biggest challenge: managing her out-ofcontrol sweet tooth. Growing up in

Colombia, Sofía ate lots of ice cream, chocolate, cake and other sweets foods she still loves but now limits to less frequent indulgences.

AT FULL STRENGTH

Though she didn't work with Sofía, registered dietitian Leslie Bonci, owner of Active Eating Advice in Pittsburgh, says the keys to Sofía's success were "cutting out a lot of the high-calorie sweets and snack items that were calorie bombs. She emphasized produce more throughout the day, which lets you eat a bigger volume of food so you feel full for fewer calories. She also limited her alcohol, which can be an appetite enhancer." While Sofía says she doesn't enjoy exercise, she does Pilates workouts, spin classes and strength training several times per week. When cutting calories, regular exercise helps protect muscle mass to some extent, but consuming enough protein is essential, Bonci says. Sofía's husband, who maintains his bodybuilder-like physique by working out six days a week, sticks with a high-protein diet, and Sofía seems to have upped her protein intake — a good move "because that way you can lose body fat and preserve muscle," Bonci says. That's a winning formula in anyone's book! 🛂







THE POWER OF PROTEIN

Your body needs protein to help repair cells and make new ones, to provide structure and strength to various tissues, to help regulate biochemical reactions (including metabolism) and to make enzymes, hormones and other substances that are used in essential body functions. While trying to lose weight, consuming enough dietary protein is extra important to help minimize muscle loss, which could lead to a metabolic meltdown (causing you to burn fewer calories 24/7), dietitian Leslie Bonci warns. "If you're going to cut calories, protein should be represented at each meal," Bonci says.

PLAYING THE PERCENTAGES

To lose body fat and preserve lean muscle mass, remake your plate so that grains or starches (such as wholegrain pasta or a small potato) make up 20 percent of the plate, lean protein (like fish, poultry or eggs) takes up 40 percent, and produce (veggies and fruits) contributes 40 percent. An added perk of prioritizing protein: It takes longer to break down than fats or carbohydrates do, which means you'll stay full and burn calories for longer during the digestive process.






