



Scarlett's parents won't be returning this series





T: The girls have been fine. **G:** Yeah, it's been more of a problem for the whole group.

Have you met James Lock's new girlfriend, Yazmin Oukhellou? Is she someone you think you'll get on with?

T: I don't really know her that well, but she seems alright. **G:** I only met her briefly, but she appears to be a nice girl and James seems happy.

Is it weird filming without Danielle Armstrong? Do you miss her?

T: Yes, Dani was a very big character for TOWIE. She's very opinionated.

G: I miss her, but I know she is happy, so that helps. She felt it was her time to go.

Who will fill her role now?








Lindsay Lohan

to fashion.









I wish we could just pick up and do Kenan & Kel: The Grown-Up Years, getting everyone back working together. I feel like it would be an awesome moment for everybody.' However, we've yet to see them reunite. Come on boys, do it for us.
