




Selena & The Weeknd **HEADING FOR A FALL**






An audience with Blue!

ver since Kim Kardashian's terrifying hold-up in Paris, things haven't been the same between the reality star and her rapper hubby Kanye West. The once-inseparable pair have rarely been spotted in each other's company over the past few months - and now, OK! can reveal why.



ive months after Angelina Jolie filed for divorce from Brad Pitt, the public sledging and accusations have finally died down from both camps. 'In the two months leading up to her decision to file for divorce, he had threatened to publicly dissolve the relationship six times. She was afraid and she wanted to beat him to the punch.' But she didn't want to be seen as the one that got dumped, so she rushed to make it look like he was the bad guy and vilified him."

According to lan, their divorce was a long time coming, with the celebrity biographer claiming that Brad and Angelina knew their marriage was well and truly over while filming their last movie together, By the Sea.



'The set of that movie became very toxic. They were uncontrollable, arguing incessantly. It was vicious,' says lan, adding this was the last straw in their embattled union. 'Once it was over, they realised they had expired.'





WHO WILL SPEAK OUT?

Angelina knows Brad has many celeb supporters who will vouch for him, including Melissa Etheridge and Chelsea Handler, who have both expressed their dislike for the actress. However, Ange has also become paranoid about her own friends turning against her. '[She] is particularly keen to know if anyone she still considers close to her has spoken to lan. She's unsure of who her true friends are.' spills an insider. 'She's endured a huge backlash and it's led her to regret her decision to go public with all the divorce proceedings. She's terrified this will taint her legacy as an actress and humanitarian forever.'



THEY WEREN'T COMPATIBLE

While their relationship appeared pictureperfect on paper, lan reveals that, behind closed doors, it was a different story. 'They were fundamentally incompatible, and people will be surprised to see how divided they were from the get-go,' he tells. or a few years, I was a little bit lost as an artist, not being able to find what I wanted to do and making choices that I wasn't, ultimately, very happy with, admits actress Reese Witherspoon.

It was this lack of diversity that found the 40-year-old Oscar winner at a turning point in her career. 'I think literally one studio had a project for a female lead over 30, Reese recalls. 'I thought to myself, "I've got to get busy." Nobody's to blame for the situation in Hollywood, but you can either sit around and talk about how bad it is or you can do something about it.

And so she did. In addition to forming production company Pacific Standard - responsible for the Oscar-nominated Gone Girl and Wild, among others - the mum-of-three teamed up with Otter Media to form Hello Sunshine, a joint venture focused on telling female-driven stories on film, TV and digital platforms.

Their first project? Big Little Lies, a comedydrama miniseries about five women whose seemingly perfect lives become increasingly tangled and start to unravel. Based on the bestselling book by Australian author Liane Moriarty, it sparked a bidding war among the major TV networks.

'[I was tired of seeing] women of incredible talent playing wives and girlfriends in thankless parts - I'd just had enough, reveals Reese. 'So it's a unique privilege to be able to come to other women with a piece of material that I feel deeply proud of.

Here, the bubbly blonde star opens up about mum life, finding balance and the huge changes taking place in Hollywood...

With a fashion line, a production company, a busy acting career and three kids, you are one busy lady! How do you juggle it all? I'm just trying to hold on... My older kids [Ava, 17, and Deacon, 13] help with the little one [Tennessee, four]. It's nice to

have a big family. My mother worked, and I think it's good for kids to see women working and being successful. It's going to make them hard workers because they see that I don't get much sleep, but I love what I do. I want them to grow up with passion; this is the one life you get – and you have to live it to the very end.

So are you nailing the 'working mum' thing? No-one's really doing it perfectly. I think you love your kids with your whole heart, and you do the best you possibly can. There are some sacrifices you make, and it hurts your heart sometimes, but my kids tell me they're proud of what I've accomplished, and that just means everything.

MY KIDS TELL ME THEY'RE PROUD... AND THAT JUST MEANS EVERYTHING

What do you want to teach your children? If you never try, you'll never know. I'm always putting myself out there and always say to the kids, 'You know, sometimes you just have

to jump two feet into a cold pool. Maybe it's going to pay off, maybe it's not, but at least you took the chance.

Can you tell us what's it like being a mum in the digital age?

I have two teenagers, and I've discovered that they will Snapchat me back, but they will not call me back!

You launched your Draper James fashion label in 2015. Tell us a bit about that!

It's a different experience, but I'm enjoying learning something new. I like the challenge of trying something [other than acting], too. There are a lot of people talking about New

York and Los Angeles, but there's a whole world out there... and that's who I like to tell stories about and make products for – people who love the life they have, and have a sense of style that's uniquely their own.

You turned 40 last year - what's changed since you hit Hollywood in your twenties? I'm much more open now. In my twenties, I was scared of everything. I didn't know what my career was. I didn't know why people liked my movies. I was wary of interacting with people. I was 25 when Legally Blonde came out, 26 for Sweet Home Alabama and 29 for Walk the Line. And I was scared... Now I feel like a different person. It's a great thing, getting older: you are who you are; you say what you mean... I've realised that life is too short to spend my time with anybody who doesn't appreciate me, treat me with respect or bring value to the relationship. I'm much more confident now. I feel like I have the ability to say, 'Nope, I don't want to work with that person.

You've come a long way! What inspired you to start producing your own films? [My husband Jim Toth] said, 'You should produce movies. You read more books than anybody I know – you should buy some of them and turn them into films.'

You must read a lot of books and scripts. Why did *Big Little Lies* stand out?

It was such a unique opportunity to have women of every age, of every colour, talking about motherhood... Parenthood is a good equaliser, socio-economically, and everything brings these five different women together in a way that they clash, but they also understand and discover each other.

Did any of the characters resonate with you when you first read the book?

I saw myself at different stages of motherhood all through my life. [The book] explores so many aspects that are relatable to the lives of women; it wasn't about them being good or bad – they showed every spectrum and every colour of women's lives.

You're very passionate about finding stories that represent different kinds of women...

I'm passionate because things have to change. We have to start seeing women on film as they really are. We need to see real women's experiences, whether it involves domestic violence, whether it involves sexual assault, whether it involves motherhood or romance or infidelity or divorce. We need to see these things because we, as human beings, learn from art – and what can you do if you never see it reflected?
