PROUDLY SHOWING OFF HER BABY BUMP

SHE'S PREGNANT AND SHE'S WORTH IT!

ENDING MONTHS OF SPECULATION, A HEAVILY PREGNANT **CHERYL** APPEARS IN A NEW L'ORÉAL CAMPAIGN SHOOT



The All Worth It campaign shots left fans in no doubt about Cheryl's pregnancy!

After one of the most talked-about pregnancies in showbiz history, Cheryl has unveiled the first official picture of her baby bump! Cradling her growing tum in a fitted black outfit, the 33-year-old left fans in little doubt that she is pregnant in a campaign shot from the new collaboration between the Prince's Trust and L'Oréal Paris. The star – who is expecting her first child with 23-year-old boyfriend Liam Payne and who are thought to have been dating since December 2015 – hasn't publicly commented on the pregnancy but these glowing images of the former Girls Aloud star finally verify the exciting news.

Cheryl – who is believed to be eight months pregnant in these images taken in January – has worked with the Prince's Trust and L'Oréal for many years. Back in 2015, she set up her own branch of the charity called Cheryl's Trust to help underprivileged youngsters in the North East and she recently shared with fans the exciting news that a charity centre was being opened in her hometown of Newcastle. 'I am so happy and excited to

tell you all that after a 5 year relationship with @PrincesTrust and a 2 year mission along with Cheryl's Trust we have finally found a centre in Newcastle that will be opened this summer!' she wrote. The singer added: 'Part of me is still pinching myself! I wanted to say a personal thank you to each and every one of you that got involved and donated money and items/ your time over the years to help me get this off the ground.'

In the latest campaign, she is joined by 14 other ambassadors, including actress Dame Helen Mirren, TV presenter Katie Piper, singer Louisa Johnson and vlogger Marcus Butler.

As part of the charity campaign, Cheryl and the other stars recorded videos of inspirational messages. And pregnancy seems to suit Cheryl as she radiates health in the film. At one point, she places her hands on her hips and says: 'We're all worth it,' adding: 'What makes us different is what makes us beautiful.' Cheryl also revealed her maternal side in the campaign when she urged youngsters to: 'Realise your potential, build your confidence and change your life.'

very well at school at all.' Adding: 'There's moments in life where you might feel things are failures but they're actually just learning curves so you can't be afraid to fail. But I think you've got to experience stuff to feel that way and I'm definitely at a place now where I don't feel like I fail at things, I feel like I learn.' She continues: 'There are absolutely options out there and steps you can take to better the way you're feeling. Don't ever just sit there feeling sad, feeling excluded. Don't ever feel alone because there are many of us out there that want to help. I think what initially inspired to me to get involved with the Prince's Trust is when I realised if I just went back a little bit to the way I was feeling before, I could help people to motivate themselves and to achieve better things.'

The videos were shown at a launch event for the partnership between the Prince's Trust and L'Oréal Paris on February 23, which OK! attended. While Dame Helen Mirren spoke at the event and many of the campaign's stars were at the launch at the charity's centre in Kennington, south London, Cheryl wasn't in attendance. And the singer's no show sparked rumours that she has already given birth, although as OK! went to press, there was no confirmation of this. On February 9, Kimberley Walsh posted a throwback picture tribute to Cheryl on Instagram and Sarah Harding followed it up with one on Valentine's Day. Eagle-eyed fans speculated they were covertly congratulating their former bandmate on her baby's arrival.

At the Prince's Trust event, activist Katie Piper, who released a book called *Confidence: The Secret* last year, told OK! of Cheryl's pregnancy: 'We shot on separate days so the first time I saw her was in that picture of us all but she looks really well. It's lovely.'

The new three-year collaboration, 'All Worth It', between the Prince's Trust – founded by HRH the Prince of Wales in 1976 – and L'Oréal is aiming to help 10,000 young people across the UK turn their self-doubt into self-worth. Newly released figures from the Prince's Trust reveal that one in three young people do not believe in themselves. The campaign's slogan is a twist on L'Oréal's motto: 'Because I'm worth it', changing it to: 'Because we're all worth it.'

Offering her advice to young people in one of the campaign videos, which was also filmed during her pregnancy, Cheryl opens up about times where she has felt moments of self-doubt and how she has overcome them. She reveals: 'There was definitely a time when I struggled with self-doubt. I would say more so in my life when I was a teenager was when I first came about experiencing those feelings of doubting yourself, doubting your decisions. I wasn't doing

Former Girls Aloud star Cheryl, who was officially divorced from her second husband, restaurateur Jean-Bernard Fernandez Versini in October 2016, has been open about her desire to become a mum for some time. Back in 2012 – while she was still single – she revealed she was, 'obsessed with babies'. 'I love kids. I know that's what I was put on earth to do – to be a mother,' she said.

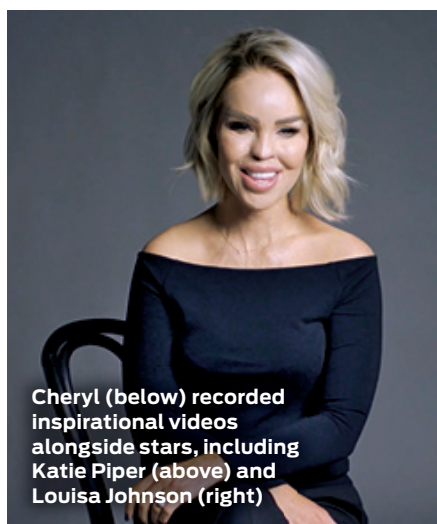
Meanwhile, just before the first official pictures of Cheryl's bump were revealed, her boyfriend Liam was partying at the BRIT Awards. He took to the stage alongside his manager Simon Cowell and *X Factor* judge Nicole Scherzinger to accept One Direction's award for Best British Video for their single *History*. As

One Direction are currently on a hiatus, Liam accepted the award on behalf of his bandmates, saying: 'Thank you so much! We cannot believe we are still winning these. Thank you very much.' He also took the opportunity to reassure fans that One Direction were still together, despite their break. 'We have been taking some time out working on our solo music, but One Direction is who we are and who we will always be,' he said (see page 20 for more from the BRITs).

Meanwhile, it seems that Cheryl and Liam have been busy nesting, with reports revealing that Liam's Surrey mansion is undergoing transformations. However, while most parents-

However, dad-to-be Liam may lock horns with his girlfriend when it comes to naming their new arrival. While Cheryl has cited her favourite name for a boy as Alfie, Liam said in 2015: 'I like the name Taylor. Taylor's neutral for a boy or a girl. That's what I'm going to call my first child.'

And Cheryl's former *X Factor* boss Simon gave his blessing when news emerged that she and Liam were trying for a baby soon after getting together. In July 2016, he said: 'Cheryl would be an amazing mum. I have seen her with my son Eric and other kids and she is incredible. I think she is in a good place in her life right now.'

Fans have been speculating about the pregnancy for months and although there have been numerous

to-be think of adding a nursery or baby proofing their pad, Liam is said to be upgrading his six-bedroom Surrey home with a brand-new basement gym, swimming pool and super-sized snooker room!

Cheryl has also apparently asked both her and Liam's mums to move in following the baby's arrival. A source revealed: 'Joan [Cheryl's mum] and Karen [Liam's mum] are keen to lend a helping hand. Also, Karen is a nursery nurse so she has a lot of hands-on experience with babies.' The source also said: 'Both mothers are excited but have put a time limit on their stay as they know it's important for Cheryl and Liam to have their space – and quality time as a new family.' Also, in January, Cheryl and Liam took delivery of a £1,250 Silver Cross pram fit for a prince or princess as Silver Cross is the same brand used by the Duchess of Cambridge for Prince George and Princess Charlotte's prams.

During Cheryl's marriage to Jean-Bernard in 2015, she insisted that she wasn't in any rush to become a mother. She said that motherhood was 'something that happens naturally.' She added: 'I'm just going to go with the flow. Whatever Mother Nature gives us...' But, it seems her priorities changed once she and Liam were an item!

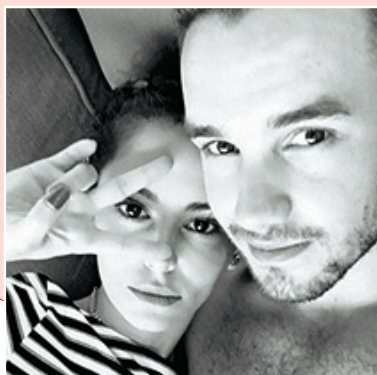
JAN 9, 2016 Cheryl and JB's split is confirmed. The singer cites the restaurateur's 'unreasonable behaviour' in divorce papers.

FEB 28 The first picture of the pair emerges showing them shopping at Tesco in Guildford, Surrey, near Liam's home. A few days later, they upload pictures of themselves in Liam's car. It emerges that the couple had enjoyed a luxury holiday to the Maldives over Valentine's Day.

MAR 2 Cheryl teases fans with a picture of herself with Liam and two men on Instagram (below), with the caption: 'My mystery man line up #whosthemysteryman #whoisit #whosworthit.'



MAR 5 The pair are seen heading into the exclusive Crocford's casino in London's Mayfair on a date.

MAR 8 Liam posts a picture of Cheryl captioned: 'Happy #internationalwomensday to my favourite woman in the world hope I make you as happy as you make me X [sic]'

MAR 9 Liam and Cheryl head to dinner at London's Salmontini le Resto with Cheryl wearing a LOVE necklace (right).

APR 12 The couple enjoy a date at London restaurant Sexy Fish, arriving hand in hand.

APR 17 Cheryl denies hurtful rumours she cheated on JB with Liam, tweeting: 'If anybody believes the s**t they're reading today you really don't know me at all.'



MAY 9 The couple make their red carpet debut at the Global Gift Gala, held at the Four Seasons Hotel in Paris (above).

MAY 11 Cheryl and Liam are seen boarding a private jet to the French Riviera for the glamorous Cannes Film Festival.

MAY 12 On arrival in the South of France, the pair hit the red carpet at the Trophée Chopard party (above right).

JUN 11 Things look to be getting serious as Cheryl is invited to Liam's sister Ruth's wedding. Much is made of Cheryl's unflattering grey dress (see over the page), but sweet Ruth calls her 'one of the most beautiful women in the world' on Twitter.

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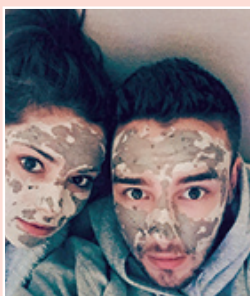

She might be a mum already, but that hasn't stopped pregnant Rochelle posing some interesting questions about her pregnancy. Posting a picture of her huge bump on Instagram last week (right), she asked her followers to help identify a dark line that's appeared on her tummy. The singer-turned-presenter was in fact referring to the linea nigra, a naturally occurring line on the skin that appears darker around week 23 of pregnancy. Rochelle, 27, has toddler daughter Alaia-Mai with husband Marvin (above), 31, and says the three year old is desperate for a sister. The little one has told her bemused parents that if the new baby, due in March, is a boy: 'We'll just send it back!'



AMY CHILDS

The first-time mum-to-be exclusively revealed she's expecting a baby with boyfriend Bradley Wright in OK!. Due in May, Amy's admitted she's 'really scared' of the birth but plans to have her hair and nails done beforehand, adding: 'My boobs have been so sore and I've got hairier – I've got a beard!' British human rights lawyer Amal showed off her bump for the first time last Friday at the César Awards Ceremony in Paris (left). Her doting husband has revealed that Amal is going to be cautious with her future work-related travels, explaining: 'Amal will no longer go to places like Iraq.'

George's friend Julie Chen originally revealed the news on her show *The Talk*, but close pal Matt Damon has said George told him about the pregnancy back when Amal was only eight weeks along. Revealing he 'almost started crying' at the news, the actor said the couple (below) will be 'awesome parents'.



BILLIE FAIERS

Former *TOWIE* star Billie is hoping for a natural labour when she has her second child with fiancé Greg Shepherd. Due on March 7, the star – who already has a daughter Nelly, two (below) – admits they were 'in complete shock' when they discovered she's expecting a boy, saying, 'I always thought we'd just have girls!'

Hinting that they'll probably opt for a traditional name when their son arrives, she confessed that she can't wait to dress him 'like Prince George'.

Greg treated the 27 year old to a fabulous baby moon in Dubai last November, and Billie also enjoyed a glamorous baby shower recently, which was featured exclusively in *OK!* (far right).



BINKY FELSTEAD

The first *Made In Chelsea* baby will arrive later this year after Binky Felstead revealed she and co-star Josh 'JP' Patterson (above right) are expecting. The news not only came as a shock to their castmates, but to Binky herself. She admitted: 'My first reaction was: 'S**t,' and I burst into tears.' But while the on/off couple weren't together when they discovered the news, Binky is now happier than ever.

Calling her pregnancy a 'huge gift' she told *OK!*: 'We're getting on better than ever, so this news has actually been a real blessing.' Binky, 26, showed off her growing bump when she joined JP, 27, at London Fashion Week recently (top). The Australian TV producer and model is expecting her first child with singer husband Ronan, who turns 40 on Friday. But while Storm, 35, looked positively glowing at London Fashion Week recently (left), she's admitted to suffering severe morning sickness. Ronan – who's already dad to Jack, 17, Missy, 16, and 11-year-old Ali with his ex-wife Yvonne Connolly – heaped praise on Storm, who's due around the end of May, saying: 'I love her bump – it's so petite and beautiful – and she looks incredible, very sexy.'

Meanwhile, Storm's credited her man with being very hands-on, adding: 'He's too supportive sometimes – I have to tell him to stop! He does everything for everyone all the time.'

NATALIE PORTMAN

Hollywood star Natalie is due to give birth to her second child with husband Benjamin Millepied (below) any day now. The 35 year old joked with Oscars host Jimmy Kimmel about his willingness to deliver the baby should she go into labour during the ceremony. And despite her cravings for healthy pineapple and cucumbers, she also revealed that she's been getting 'a little panicky about food availability' when out and about, often filling up on 'a plate of pancakes or a veggie burger' before leaving her house. Natalie – who already has a five-year-old son, Aleph, with Benjamin, 39 – hasn't settled on a name for their new offspring. She says they've first 'gotta meet the baby and then figure it out'.



IRINA SHAYK

There's a big year ahead for Irina and her man Bradley Cooper, as the couple – who are rumoured to be engaged – look set to become parents for the first time. The pair were spotted having a romantic Valentine's Day picnic on LA's Venice Beach (above), with Irina's bump clearly visible under her tight black T-shirt and leggings. Perhaps checking out where she could take their new addition on its first holiday, the Russian model was also recently spotted on a trip to Disneyland with her sister.

Rumours of the pregnancy first started back in late November when Irina, 31 – who is reportedly due in May – was seen with a hint of a bump as she walked in the Victoria's Secret Fashion Show. She and 42-year-old Bradley, who have been dating since April 2015, are said to have already picked out baby names after finding out the sex in December – though the private pair haven't commented on the speculation.

SOPHIE HUNTER

Theatre director Sophie and her actor husband Benedict Cumberbatch are 'absolutely thrilled' to be expecting their second child. The couple – who already have 18-month-old son Christopher – revealed their news in November at the premiere of *Doctor Strange* (right). Sophie, 38, displayed her blossoming bump in a gorgeous silk dress by Valentino. *Sherlock* star Benedict, 40 – who celebrated his first wedding anniversary with Sophie on Valentine's Day – said he planned to 'be there all the way' for his wife.

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'LEWIS IS A LYING, CHEATING SCUMBAG'

AFTER HE'S CAUGHT WITH ANOTHER WOMAN ON CAMERA, **MARNIE SIMPSON** DUMPS **LEWIS BLOOR** AND BRANDS HIM A SERIAL CHEAT

Devastated *Geordie Shore* star Marnie Simpson has been left heartbroken after her boyfriend Lewis Bloor's infidelities with two women.

Former *TOWIE* star Lewis said he was a 'fool' in a lengthy Instagram post, adding: 'I am utterly disappointed in myself for hurting such an amazing girl, she did not deserve any of the pain I have caused.' He continued: 'It was a drunken mistake, a terrible thing. I wish I'd had the courage to admit my wrongdoing so Marnie did not have to find out from these girls.'

Earlier in the week, Marnie had claimed via Twitter that Lewis cheated on her during a recent holiday to Barcelona. Marnie, however, insisted she was in love with him, saying: 'I've literally just spent seven months of my life with an absolute phoney, a lying, cheating scumbag.'

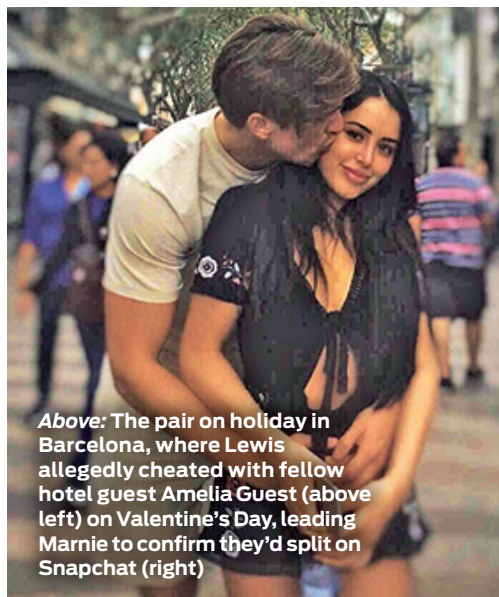
Meanwhile, Marnie's *Geordie Shore* co-star and former boyfriend Aaron

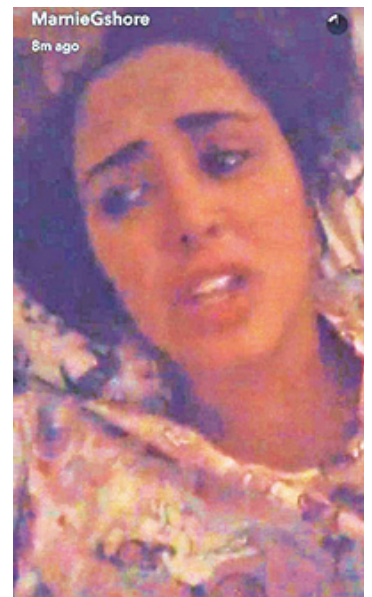

The biggest night on the British music calendar, last week's BRIT Awards saw Little Mix celebrate one of the most monumental moments of their career.

for helping us to do an amazing song. This one's for you, lads!'

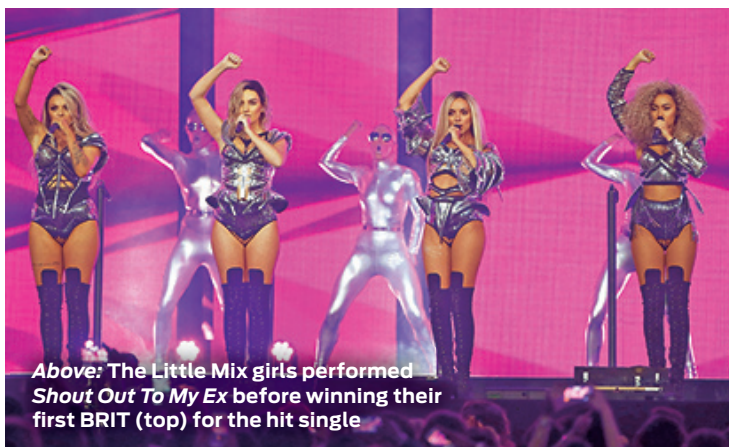

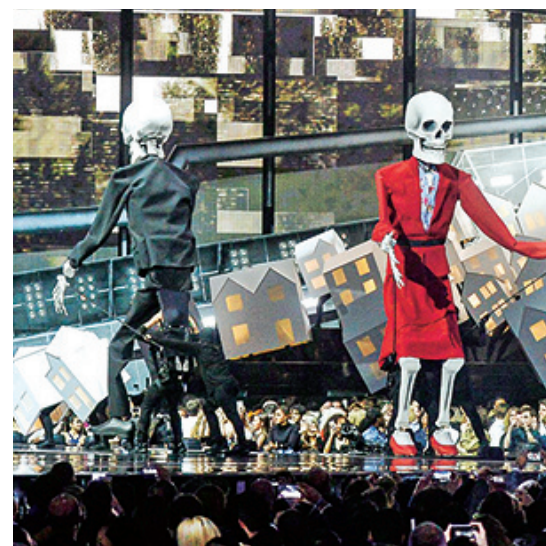

Hotel. With the band scheduled to jet to New York a few hours later to resume their tour with Ariana Grande, smitten Chris captioned the shot: 'I don't want this girl to go back America tomorrow!'

Yet their early flight didn't deter the girls from celebrating, with Perrie telling us on the red carpet: 'We're excited we're performing first, because we can get on the bevvies after!'

They certainly lived up to her word, with Jesy reportedly spotted licking their award as they emerged from the ceremony, before saying: 'I'm really sorry, we're drunk, I don't give a s**t!' Perhaps feeling the effects, the Essex girl kept a low profile as she hid behind her shades the following morning while heading to the airport.

Keeping up the girl power, Katy Perry showcased her new single *Chained To The Rhythm* in her first-ever BRITs performance. The star was joined by dancing houses and giant skeletons dressed as US President Donald Trump and Prime Minister Theresa May, as she belted out politically charged lyrics like: 'It is my desire/Break down the walls to connect, inspire/Up in your high place, liars/Time is ticking for the empire.'

However, that wasn't the biggest talking point of her set. There was an embarrassing moment when one of Katy's house dancers fell off the stage, sending Twitter into a frenzy. Katy herself suffered an awkward altercation on the night.

During a fraught red carpet interview, Capital FM's George Shelley and Lilah Parsons told the star: 'We won't keep you too long,' to which she replied, 'Oh alright, I'm leaving! Fine, I'll leave!' After a brief chat, Lilah attempted to wrap up the interview, telling the star: 'Katy Perry, thanks so much for chatting with us. We're going to let you go,' with the international pop star quipping: 'You're gonna let me go? I'm firing you!' before walking away. Even a request for a mic drop from George wasn't enough to lure Katy back.

Unable to join her fellow A-listers at the ceremony, Adele – who recently swept the board at the Grammys – scooped the Global Success Award. Accepting her gong via pre-recorded video link, the star gushed: 'You have all been amazing to me this past year. It's been amazing this year, the best one yet. Have a good time!' The mum of one added: 'Get a bit swervy like her!' as she gestured to her trophy, designed by the late Dame Zaha Hadid.

Meanwhile, speculation continues over whether the chart-topper has wed her long-time love Simon Konecki. The charity boss was in the BRITs audience wearing a gold ring on his wedding finger. When Adele waved during her acceptance video, eagle-eyed fans spotted her wearing a gold ring on her wedding finger, too.

Beyoncé, to whom Adele previously dedicated her Best Album Grammy, also received a nod. She was awarded International Female Solo Artist, but the star – who is currently pregnant with twins – was also unable to attend.

Following Adele's touching Grammy tribute to the late George Michael – who passed away at his home on Christmas Day last year at the age of 53 – the icon was honoured once again. ▶

Silence fell across the arena as George's former Wham! bandmate Andrew Ridgeley and backing singers Pepsi DeMacque and Shirlie Holliman reunited on stage to honour their friend in an emotional speech. Andrew said: 'On Christmas Day 2016, the greatest singer-songwriter of his generation, an icon of his era, and my beloved friend, George Michael, was lost,' adding: 'A supernova in a ferment of shining stars had been extinguished, and it felt like the sky had fallen in. George has left for us in his songs, in the transcendental beauty of his voice, and poetic expression of his soul, the very best of himself.' Emotionally, he told the audience: 'I loved him and in return, we, you, have been loved.'

Struggling to hold back her tears, Shirlie added: 'George was like a brother to me and will always be. His wonderful way with words spoke to everyone and his beautiful voice will live on forever as a gift to us all.'

Coldplay frontman Chris Martin then stepped up to give an emotional rendition of the pop legend's number one hit *A Different Corner*. During the performance, archive footage of George played behind him, saying: 'I never really wanted to be somebody else.'



Recordings of George's iconic voice were then played, with Chris and George duetting in harmony for the remainder of the song. The rendition was met with a standing ovation and OK! can confirm there wasn't a dry eye in the house.

Another beloved icon, David Bowie – who died of cancer in January 2016 at the age of 69 – was also honoured with his second and third posthumous BRIT Awards, for Best British Male and Best British Album, for *Blackstar*. His son, film director Duncan Jones, accepted one of the trophies and dedicated them to 'all the kooks and all the people who make kooks' – a

reference to David's 1971 track *Kooks*.

First-time BRITs hosts Emma Willis and Dermot O'Leary paid tribute to an absent Michael Bublé, who was forced to pull out of presenting the show after his three-year-old son Noah was diagnosed with cancer. Dermot admitted: 'We would rather be watching Bublé on stage,' with Emma adding: 'Everybody sends him their love. Fingers crossed we will see him again next year.' The pair's turn was met with praise from fans on social media, with some naming them 'the best BRITs presenters ever' and 'a precious pair for TV'.

Ahead of releasing his third album *Divide* this week, Ed Sheeran blasted through his hit *Castle On The Hill* before being joined by grime posterboy Stormzy for Ed's number one single *Shape Of You*. The rapper famously took aim at the BRITs in his track *One Take Freestyle* after no black or minority artists were nominated in the British categories last year. Stormzy then met with BRITs chairman Ged Doherty, and the judging panel and voting system were altered to increase diversity.

After the ceremony, Stormzy and Ed partied at the Warner Music and Cîroc after-party at

Flying solo for the night was Liam Payne, who made a surprise appearance to accept the British Video award for One Direction's *History*. His girlfriend Cheryl confirmed their pregnancy news the morning after the show, showing an enormous baby bump in shots to launch the Prince's Trust's All Worth It campaign with L'Oréal Paris.

Liam's mentor Simon Cowell presented him with the award alongside fellow *X Factor* judge Nicole Scherzinger. With the music mogul playfully refusing to let his co-host speak, some fans suggested that Scherzy may have had a few drinks too many! Simon's congratulations speech was also awkwardly cut off, as he was plunged into darkness mid-sentence.

Robbie Williams was honoured with the BRITs Icon Award – his 18th BRIT – and took to the stage for an epic medley of *The Heavy Entertainment Show*, *Love My Life* and *Mixed Signals*, alongside a team of scantily clad dancers. Ever the professional, Robbie wasn't fazed when two of

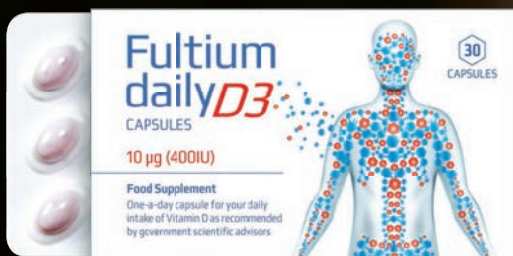

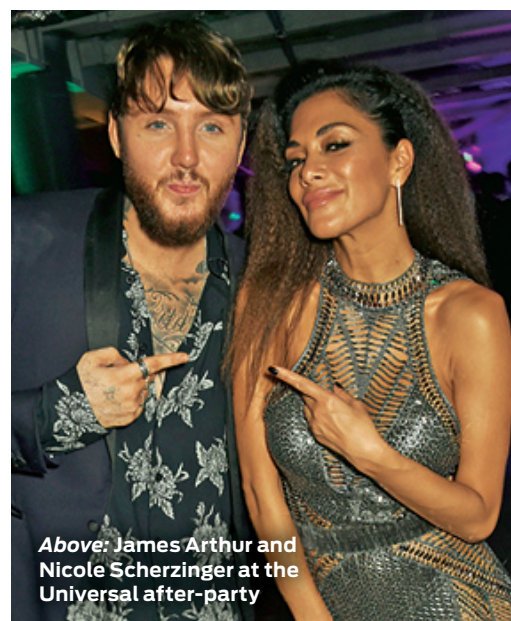

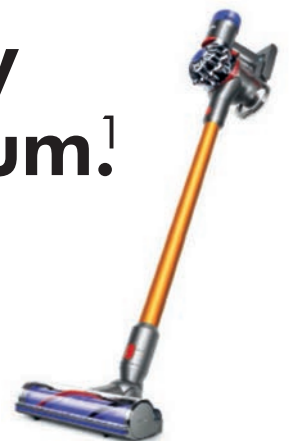

After initially maintaining a dignified silence, Angelina Jolie has opened up about her 'difficult' marriage break-up last year. During an interview in Siem Reap, Cambodia, ahead of the premiere for her latest film, *First They Killed My Father*, she appeared to well up with tears as she spoke about her split from husband Brad Pitt.

The actress-turned-director, who shares six children with her estranged spouse, took a deep breath and looked visibly emotional as she said: 'I don't want to say very much about that, except to say it was a very difficult time.' She added: 'We will always be a family and we will get through this time and hopefully be a stronger family for it.'

Angelina, 41, filed for divorce from Brad, 53, requesting full custody of their children last September following an incident on board a private jet. During the interview with BBC World News, she told presenter Yalda Hakim: 'My focus is my children, our children.'

Insisting that she was 'coping', Angelina gave a fascinating glimpse of her family life in recent months, describing how two of her children have been sharing her bed. She also admitted that her first aim on waking up has been to 'get through the day'.

The Hollywood star had brought her children – Maddox, 15, Pax, 13, Zahara, 12, and Shiloh, ten, and eight-year-old twins Vivienne and Knox – along with her on the trip to southeast Asia.

They joined her for the film's world premiere at the Terrace of the Elephant in the ancient Angkor Wat temple complex, where Angelina looked lovely in a black dress with lace detailing on the shoulders. It was a case of Hollywood meets royalty as His Majesty King Norodom Sihamoni and Her Majesty Queen Mother Norodom Monineath Sihanouk posed for photos with Angelina and her brood.

When asked if she still believed Brad was a wonderful father, as the actress has often described her ex in the past, Angelina told ABC's *Good Morning America* in a later interview: 'Of course, of course, we will always be a family, always.' 'We will always be a family,' the star said of her estranged husband Brad Pitt



'We are focusing on the health of our family and so we will be stronger when we come out of this, because that's what we're determined to do as a family.' The Netflix movie, which is Angelina's fifth as a director, relates the true story of the Cambodian genocide. It took place in the 1970s under Pol Pot's Khmer Rouge regime. The film is told through the eyes of a child and is based on the autobiography of Angelina's friend, human rights activist Loung Ung.

Angelina adopted Maddox from Cambodia in 2002 and shared her

gratitude to the nation during a press conference, saying: 'This film is my way of saying thank you to Cambodia. Without Cambodia I may never have become a mother. Part of my heart is and will always be in this country. And part of this country is always with me: Maddox.'

Her eldest son – who worked with her on the film, reading scripts and attending production meetings along with his brother Pax – also addressed the audience. Maddox said: 'It's a great honour to present this film to all of you, and to stand by

my mother and my family. And now I'd like to introduce my little sister Shiloh, as she has something to say.'

He then handed over to his younger sibling, who was smartly dressed in a three-piece suit. The youngster then walked up to the microphone and announced: 'My name is Shiloh and I love Cambodia.'

During the trip, Angelina gave a glimpse of three new tattoos adorning her back. They were clearly visible when the A-listener accepted a bouquet of flowers from the King, graciously bowing before him in a show of respect. Wearing a hot pink chiffon gown by Schiaparelli, which featured a low back, she flashed the elaborate inkings covering her spine and right shoulder blade.

The latest additions, which bring her tattoo total to 20, match the existing Cambodian body art on her left shoulder blade, which she got when she adopted Maddox. A source claimed they are 'Buddhist blessings for peace, love and a prosperous life'.

Angelina also encouraged her children to experience some traditional Cambodian cuisine, as she instructed them on how to prepare a meal of fried tarantulas and scorpions. 'See the hard part, where you have the teeth? Take the fangs out,' she told them, expertly handling one of the dead arachnids.

As little Vivienne held up a prepped tarantula to show her mum, Angelina exclaimed: 'Good!' Shiloh was also filmed chomping on one of the sizzling hot spiders as actress and activist Angelina said: 'It's actually really good, the flavour.' However, her son Knox was less impressed by the native snacks. 'They're like flavourless chips,' he remarked. Asked by BBC correspondent Yalda how she acquired a taste for the critters, Angelina replied: 'Crickets – you start with crickets. Crickets and a beer, and then you kind of move up to tarantulas.'

Later, Angelina told *Good Morning America* that her children are used to eating unusual delicacies. 'They're used to eating scorpions, especially Shiloh,' she revealed. 'Shiloh loves a tarantula, loves a bug. They can eat a bag of crickets like a bag of chips, so they're used to it. But I'm learning to cook for them better – a little more flair, a little more seasoning.'

Here, in an excerpt from Angelina's interview with Yalda, she tells why she hopes her new film will educate the world on the brutality of the war, how she's coping with her divorce, and what she foresees for herself in five years' time...

Can you tell us why Cambodia is so important to you?

I'm not here because I'm a director who wanted to make a movie. I'm here because 17 years ago, I came to this country and I fell in love with its people and learned about its history – and in doing so, realised how little I actually knew in my early twenties about the world. And so this country, for me, was my awakening. And my son changed my life. Becoming a Cambodian family changed my life. So there was never a plan to: 'We should make this movie.' It's just, I became a filmmaker and one day I thought, what story do I feel is really important to tell? And I felt that this war that happened 40 years ago, and what happened to these people, was not properly understood. I felt that I wanted [the Cambodian people] to be able to reflect on it in a way that they could absorb, so it's through the eyes of the child and it's a lot about love.

Do you think this nation is ready for that?

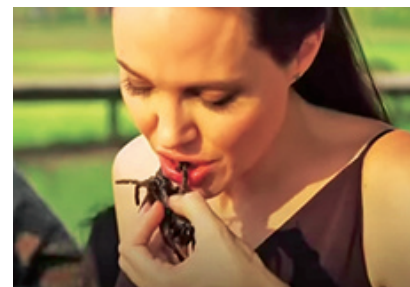
I hope so [laughs]! Yes I do. Since it happened there are many people denying the history or saying it wasn't as bad. Of course, many people want to forget; it's the horrors of war.

You say this is a country that is very much part of your own personal journey. Do you think that in many ways you've come full circle? Your humanitarian work started here, you became a mother here...

Yeah, yeah. I'll always be very grateful to this country. I don't think I could ever give back as much as this country has given me.

You wrote a *New York Times* opinion piece a few weeks ago and you spoke about having a truly international family. You said the United States refugee policy should be about fact, not fear. You also said we shouldn't be departing from 'our values'. What did you mean by that?

It's funny, isn't it? Some questions seem so obvious, don't they? It's these



things we all talk about and we hear them spoken about often. What are our values? I value life, equally. Every single individual human life. I don't separate people by race, colour or religion. And if I do, it's because I celebrate the diversity in the world.

But we're seeing this rise of populist leaders right around the world. Do you think it's creating a more intolerant society?

This is an old trick and we should know better than to fall for it. I see it rising and the only thing I can do is to use my voice and encourage others, and raise my children to know right and wrong and to have a broad view of the world, and to embrace their diversity and respect others. We all just have to be the best of ourselves. Now more than ever, we really have to rise up and find our rational centre, our 'Who are we, and what do we stand for?' We know what's right and wrong.

Your film is about family and loss. We understand this is a very sensitive

This film is a combination of passions; filmmaking as an art, your humanitarian work. In, say, five years' time, where would you like to see yourself? Where will you be?
Five years' time. Do I have all teenagers?

You have all teenagers at that stage...

At that stage, I hope just standing! In five years' time, I would like to be travelling around the world, visiting my children, hoping that they're just happy and doing really interesting things – I imagine in many different parts of the world – and I'll be supporting them. And everything I do, I hope I represent something and I represent the right things to my children, and give them the right sense of what they're capable of and the world as it should be seen. Not through the prism of Hollywood or through a certain kind of life, but really take them into the world, where they have really good sense and become rounded people.

What do you really want to do when you wake up in the morning?

Hmmm... Get through the day [laughs]! It's been a difficult few months. Right now I'm going through a moment when just everybody's in my room [laughs]! Two dogs, two hamsters and two children at the moment. It's wonderful... But usually I just wake up trying to figure out who's going to get the dog out, who's going to start the pancakes and did anybody brush their teeth? **OK!**

issue – we know that an incident occurred which led to your separation [from Brad]. We also know you haven't said anything about this. But would you like to say something?

I don't want to say very much about that, except to say it was a very difficult time and we are a family and we will always be a family, and we will get through this time and hopefully be a stronger family for it.

Can we ask how you're coping?

I am... Many, many people find themselves in this situation. My family, we've all been through a difficult time. My focus is my children, our children, and my focus is finding this way through; and as I said, we are and forever will be a family and so that is how I'm coping. I am coping with finding a way through to make sure that this somehow makes us stronger and closer.

A source said of the pair: 'They're using this time to get to know each other again away from the cameras and things are going well. It's been



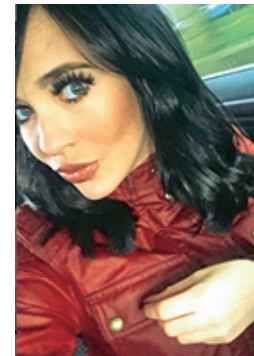

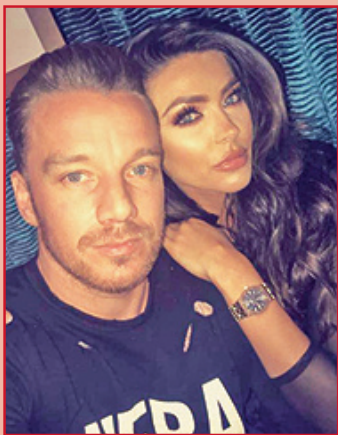
BACK ON!

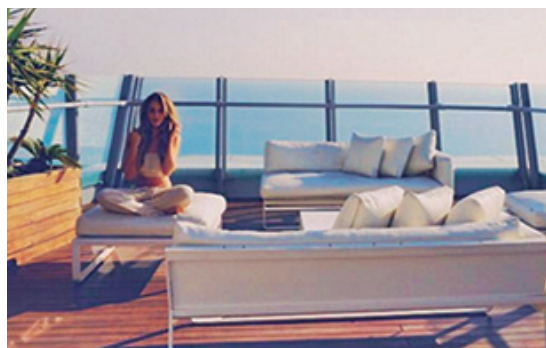

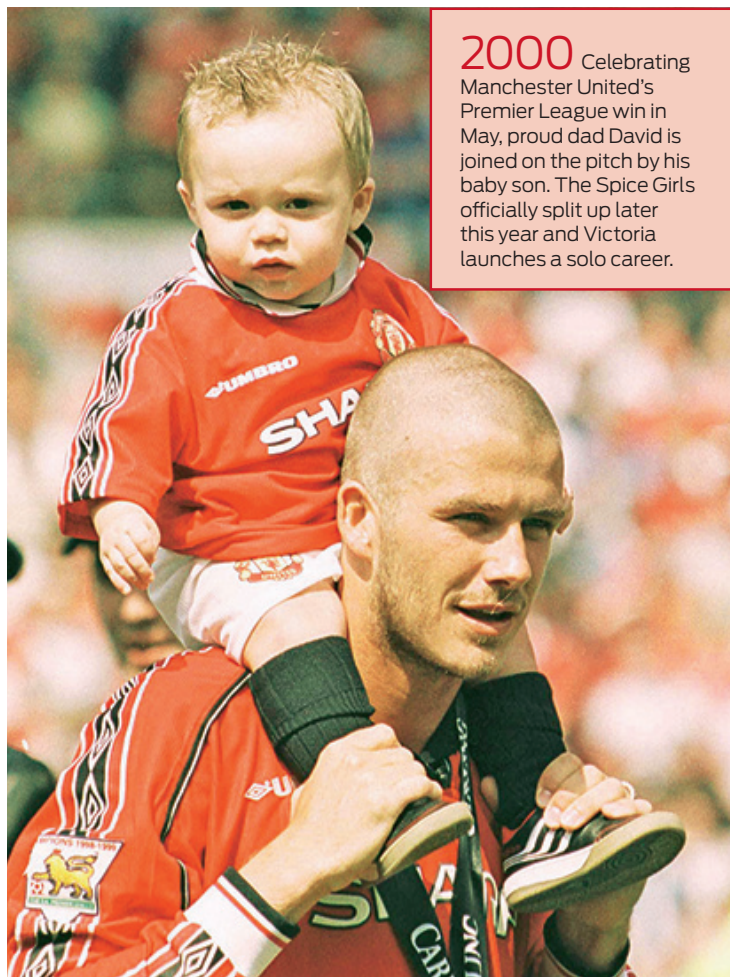


Grace Moretz, passed his driving test and forged a photography career, with a Burberry campaign under his belt.

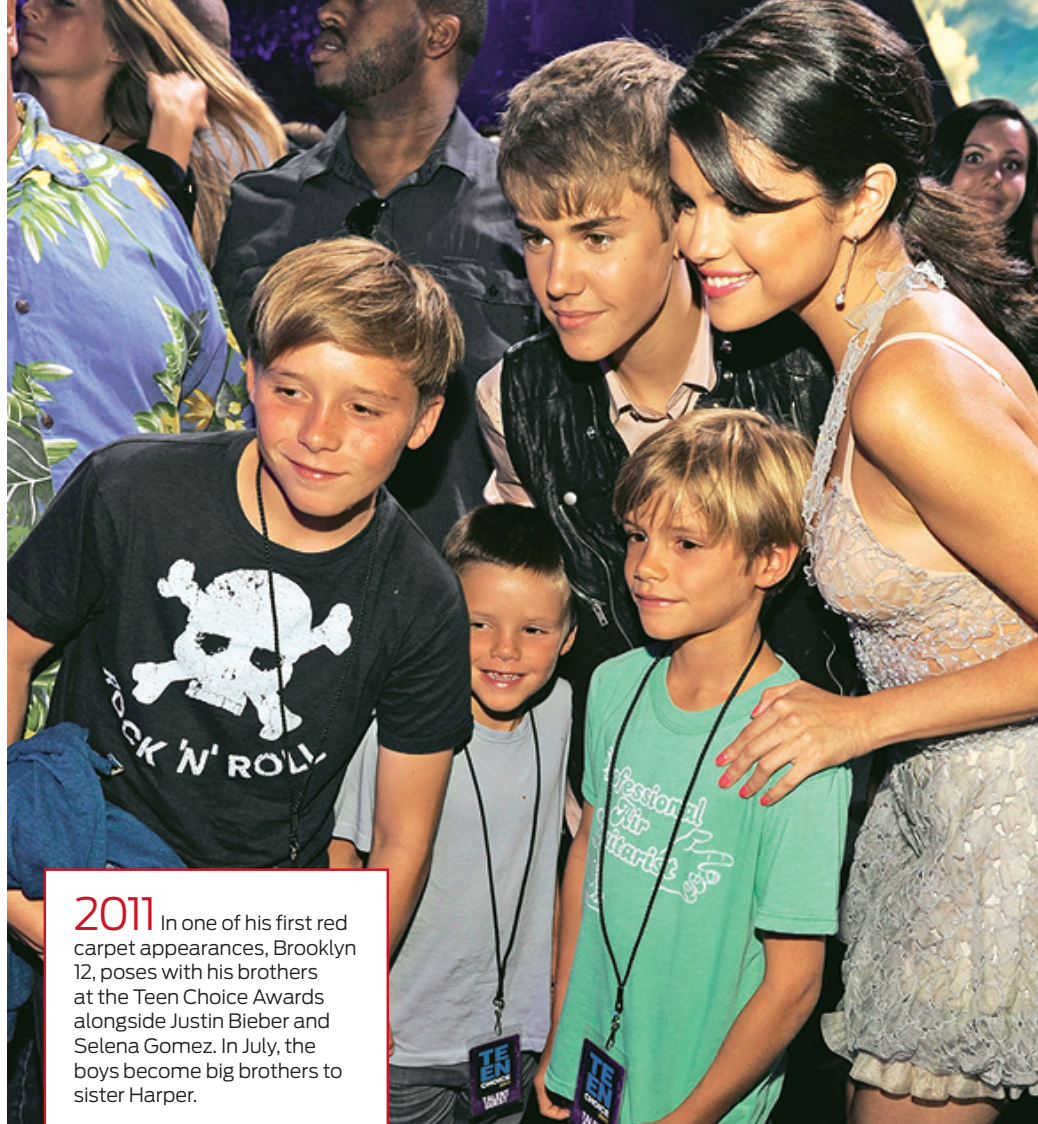

Also of note as she greeted the waiting crowds was her pared-back make-up. Following her 35th birthday in January, Kate has done away with the heavy eyeliner, matte foundation and pink blusher of old. Critics have observed that her new toned-down look of dewy foundation, cream blusher, softer brows and subtle eye shadow has taken years off her!

Kate kicked off her trip by visiting Multi-Disciplinary Intervention Support Team (MIST), a child and adolescent mental health project in Pontypool, Torfaen.

It was her first engagement with Action For Children, who head up the project, since becoming the charity's royal patron in December, a role

which until then was carried out by the Queen. The organisation cares for disadvantaged children from across the UK.

While there, she enjoyed a game of pool, although after the duchess missed a shot, her 15-year-old teammate Craig Davies remarked that 'she was dreadful'! So it seems there might be something the perfect princess doesn't excel at! Despite his crushing verdict, Craig had a good chat with Kate about her children, three-year-old Prince George and one-year-old Princess Charlotte, who didn't join her on the visit, and about their pets, family dog Lupo and hamster Marvin. 'She was really interested in talking to us,' said Craig. 'She was saying the dog was fine and that they also had a really small hamster.'

The beaming duchess was treated to a cuddle from young fan Ypapanti Galimatakis-Rees, who handed her a bouquet of yellow daffodils. She told the youngster: 'Both George and Charlotte would have loved to have met you.'

Speaking about her interest in the project, the duchess told Chris Simmonds, whose son uses the service: 'It's an area that I am so passionate about, particularly the development and early intervention of children and supporting the family structures.'

Kate's next stop was a visit to the Caerphilly Family Intervention Team (FIT) to learn about their work with children coping with emotional and behavioural difficulties, including those who are likely to self-harm. A spokesperson for Kensington Palace said that Kate was 'incredibly proud to follow the Queen as Patron of Action for Children'. They added: 'The duchess firmly believes that every child who needs it should be given the best support at the earliest opportunity.'

It was reported that security was stepped up for Kate's Welsh engagement and police were spotted with tasers and drones to keep tabs on the proceedings.

Meanwhile, a body language expert has given opinion on why Kate and her husband Prince William are never seen holding hands in public. Robin Kermode claims that the couple have taken cues from the Queen. 'The Queen rarely holds hands with her husband in public and this seems to have set an unwritten precedent for the other royals,' he said. 'They come across as a strong, independent couple and while they are always on show, they do not feel the need to "show" their love for each other to the world: **OK!**'

JENNIFER METCALFE AND HER BOYFRIEND **GREG LAKE** TELL OK!'S KIRSTY HATCHER HOW IT DIDN'T TAKE LONG TO CONCEIVE THANKS TO GREG'S 'SUPER-SWIMMERS' – HE'S JUST GOT TO GET OVER HIS FEAR OF BABIES NOW!

Jennifer Metcalfe and Greg Lake have always wanted to become parents, so when they discovered the exciting news that they were expecting their first child together, it was a dream come true. 'It's just amazing. We couldn't be more excited,' the *Hollyoaks* actress, who is nearly six months pregnant, tells OK!.

When we arrive at our exclusive shoot the couple are giddy with excitement, and Jennifer – who's played Mercedes McQueen on the Channel 4 soap for almost 11 years – is absolutely glowing, despite suffering from constant nausea during her pregnancy.

Unlike a soap storyline, Jennifer and Greg's four-year relationship has been free of drama since they started dating in 2013. They first laid eyes on each other back in 2011 when they both attended the MTV Europe Music Awards. But it wasn't until two years later that they met again when Jennifer, 33, was starring in *Cinderella* in former *Geordie Shore* star Greg's hometown of Whitley Bay, and it was after panto that their relationship progressed to more than just friends.

Of discovering she was pregnant back in October, Jennifer reveals: 'We weren't trying but we weren't actively not trying. We just got to the stage where we were like: "If this happens, it would be amazing."' Greg, 32 – who owns a heat engineering company – adds: 'Then we realised I have super-swimmers, so it was easy!'

Here, Jennifer and Greg, whose baby is due in June, exclusively reveal their pregnancy news to OK! and tell us about their excitement and nerves ahead of becoming first-time parents, and how Jen's late father Colin has been a part of the pregnancy...

I did. We'd gone to Ibiza a few weeks before we found out and my boobs were really sore to the point I'd never experienced before! I've got quite little boobs and they just blew up. I was like: 'What the hell are these?!'

Did you take a test straight away?

Jennifer: Once we got back from Ibiza I went for a meal with my girlfriends. They ordered wine and I wasn't going to have one, but I was like, do you know what, I have a feeling this could be the last one I have for a while, so I had a nice glass of Rioja and enjoyed it. Then the next day I went to the shop and bought a test, and what a surprise!

Did you do the test together?

Jennifer: No. Greg was in Newcastle working and I was in Liverpool so I just had to FaceTime him. He didn't know I was doing the pregnancy test. No one knew I was pregnant!

What a surprise for you, Greg!

B***dy hell, I know, wasn't it just!

Jennifer: I was trying to get in touch with him but I couldn't and eventually he phoned

me and I said: 'You need to FaceTime me.' Then I FaceTimed him from the kitchen with the test! It was really weird because in my kitchen I've got a picture of my dad on the windowsill and on FaceTime the picture was behind me. In the picture, my dad is holding his hands out and putting a little bowl on my head when we were in the bath. Greg was like: 'Oh my God, Jen, your dad is holding your belly!' He's not into spirits, so I was like: 'What are you talking about?' I looked and in the corner of the screen on my FaceTime, my dad's hands were holding out to my belly! It was so bizarre but really nice at the same time because my dad passed away [to cancer] when I was 15, so it was like he was a part of it.

Congratulations, both! How are you feeling, Jennifer?

I'm very excited, but it's mixed with feeling nauseous and a bit sleepy! I've not actually been sick, but I've been feeling a bit nauseous. I've been off my food and not quite myself.

Greg: I've been eating enough for the three of us! I'm having all the leftover food.

Jennifer: I don't know what his excuse has been for the past four years! Eating and sleeping is all we do. I think we've been preparing for this and we've really settled down. It really does feel like the natural time for us to have a baby. I'm nearly six months in now, just another third to go which is music to my ears!

How did you both react when you found out?

Greg: We were very, very excited. The timing couldn't have been more perfect, really.

Jennifer: When we first found out, we were like: 'Oh my God!' We didn't think it would happen so quickly and we found out so early on. It's such a miracle to even be able to conceive and you don't know if you can until you try, so to actually get one in there and see it growing, we couldn't believe it!

So were you trying to conceive?

Jennifer: We weren't trying but we weren't actively not trying. We got to the stage where we were like: 'If this happens, it would be amazing.' We took it in our stride and didn't put any pressure on ourselves.

Jennifer says that when she goes on maternity leave she'll move into Greg's Newcastle home

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It is sad he won't meet them, but I try and see the positives in everything. I like to think he's up there looking down on us and I know he'd be very proud of me and excited about this news. I have my mum here and she's made up about the news and Greg's mum and dad are, too.

Were they the first people you told?

Greg: Yes. Jen's mum lives in Leeds but we wanted her to come to Newcastle to tell her, so I rang her and I said: 'Mary, you need to come up because I need to ask you a question!' She thought I was going to ask her another question! We got her to my house in Newcastle and I was showing her around because I've just done it up, so I was saying: 'This is our bedroom, this is your bedroom and this is the baby's room!' She was like: 'What?!' And then she just burst out crying.

Jennifer: Greg always winds everybody up so she thought he was joking.

Greg: I've never seen her cry. Then we went round to my parents and we told them and they started crying! Everyone was crying.

Jennifer: And I just felt sick! We were the only ones who didn't cry. We've just been happy.

Greg: And I've been really nervous. I'm a bit scared of babies. Wherever we go and see our families there are loads of toddlers around, so I'm good with kids but I'm anxious with babies because they're so small. But it'll be a joint effort.

Jennifer: He'll have no choice when I'm having a 12-hour nap!

How was your 20-week scan, Jennifer?

It was fascinating. You could see its little tongue sticking out and it was swallowing and crossing its legs. It was magical. We could see everything

really well and apparently that's because I've not got a lot of fat on my tummy.

So you've not found out the sex?

Greg: No, we're not going to, we're having a surprise. I did initially want to, but Jen has always wanted a surprise.

Jennifer: I feel like I'm the one who's got to go through labour, so if I've got a little surprise at the end, it might be get me through however many hours it's going to be! We can't wait to meet the little man or lady. We have a few names but we're going to keep them to ourselves.

Jennifer: We're really looking forward to it. We're so used to travelling to each other's places, so it will be nice to be in the same place. I'm not sure when I go on maternity leave yet, I still need to discuss it with the producer Bryan [Kirkwood], but he was over the moon when I told him. I haven't got a clue what I'm doing so I'm just going to trust their guidance and whenever they want me to go, I'll go. But I'm willing to work until the end. *Hollyoaks* are really supportive, so it's lovely.

Do you have a birthing plan in place, Jennifer?

I don't have one and I don't want one! I'm relying on Mother Nature. Cats and dogs do it behind couches on their own and women do it in the middle of nowhere. I'm actually quite excited about the birth. I thought I would panic about getting it out, but I'm up for the challenge and I'm looking forward to the experience in a sick way [laughs]!

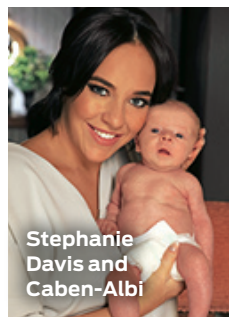
Do all your *Hollyoaks* co-stars know you're pregnant, Jennifer?

Reprising her role as Anastasia Steele in *Fifty Shades Darker*, Dakota Johnson seems thrilled to be back for the second instalment of the much-hyped film trilogy. As the daughter of Melanie Griffith and Don Johnson, and the granddaughter of Golden Globe-winning star Tippi Hedren, acting has always been in Dakota's blood.

Warm and friendly, Dakota seems to be finally getting to grips with her superstardom, yet she still finds the concept of having fans 'strange'.

The 27-year-old star also admits that the third and final instalment of the movie franchise, *Fifty Shades Freed*, out next year, will be the last time that she works with co-star Jamie Dornan. 'If we did [any more], it would be all about Christian and Ana back together, and why do that to ourselves?' she says.

Jamie, 34, recently rubbished claims that his marriage to wife Amelia Warner, also 34, had suffered after filming steamy sex scenes with Dakota, calling the rumours 'disgusting'. And it seems that Dakota, too, is rising above the gossip, saying that fellow actress Amelia is 'the coolest'.

Here, Dakota opens up about her chemistry with Jamie, why she's made her parents promise not to watch her raunchy scenes and what she'll miss most about the *Fifty Shades* films...

How do you feel about coming back and doing it all over again?

The pressure is gone – well, almost gone! We're comfortable, confident in ourselves. People liked what we did in the first movie when everything felt like a risk, everything felt nerve-wracking. How is this going to be received? How will fans take this? So knowing that was covered and ticked off is a big relief.

You and Jamie seem to be really close...

It's genuinely one of the fastest, closest friendships I've ever made in my life, just based on the amount of time we've actually known each

other. I love Jamie, I trust him and I really couldn't tell you if I could have done this without him.

What's been the best thing about working with Jamie?

He's my dream partner and supported me, I've supported him. It's a lot to ask of two people, of two actors, to take on these highly emotional, sexual situations, but I think we've done us proud. He'll be my friend for the rest of my life. I adore him, I adore his wife and his gorgeous babies. They're the most perfect little family unit.

Did you spend a lot of time with his family?

That was probably the best part of the shoot, getting to hang out and play with them [Jamie and Amelia have three-year-old daughter Dulce and one-year-old daughter Elva]. So cute.

Was it weird filming love scenes with Jamie, then hanging out with his wife?

No, she's the coolest.

Anastasia seems more mature in this movie. What was your take on that?

I loved her arc from very innocent, very inexperienced, a lack of life experience and you see this emotional, spiritual, intellectual and sexual journey from the beginning to an empowered, strong bad ass with integrity and grace. There's not a moment where I think she compromises herself. That journey was fascinating.

Jamie says the sex is better in this one – do you agree?

The sex is definitely better in this one. She knows more what she wants. She's more confident now and has an understanding of what's making him tick. Their connection is stronger, their emotions are deeper. That makes sex better, doesn't it?!

Have you lost more of your inhibitions this time around?

I don't really know if I had very strong inhibitions. I have no problem with nudity, never have, never will. I think the human body is

beautiful. I grew up being told to love your body and be comfortable with yourself.

Have you always wanted to follow in your parents' footsteps?

It was what I always dreamed of, it's what makes me happiest.

What advice did they give you, or indeed your grandmother, about the industry?

My grandmother is an idol to me, she gives me so much inspiration and strength from her words and how she navigated this industry. She tells me to trust my instincts, trust myself and be myself.

Have your parents seen the films?

No, that is not happening, nor will it ever happen! That's hard for them, just this huge movement around these movies that I'm a part of, but not being able to watch them. I know it's tough. But I made them promise and they respect that.

You have an amazing scene with Kim Basinger where you throw a drink in her face. What was that like to shoot?

I hated it! It felt awful, it's Kim Basinger, for God's sake. I kept apologising but she was like: 'Let's go again, go nuts!' I wanted to practise on Jamie, but it would have messed him up for the scene [laughs]! It's definitely one of the strangest moments in my career and probably my life.

How has your life changed since the first movie came out?


It's weird that people seem to know so much about me. That's very confronting and I don't think I'll ever get used to that. This feeling that I don't fully belong to myself any more is very strange and acosting. And I'll never find that normal. I'll never think, that's just part of my life.

You're done filming the *Fifty Shades* movies now. What will you miss most?

Jamie. I'll miss his jokes. Most of them are funny – some, not so much! **OK!**

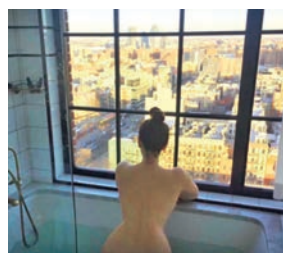
How are you enjoying being back in LA?

You've been on so many beautiful trips with Jeremy. What's the best thing about travelling with him?

The best thing about my life is that I get to travel. I get to go all over the world, so I guess having someone to share all those experiences with makes it better. To share all those amazing moments is special.

You post a lot of snaps of Kent on your Instagram page. How does it differ from LA?

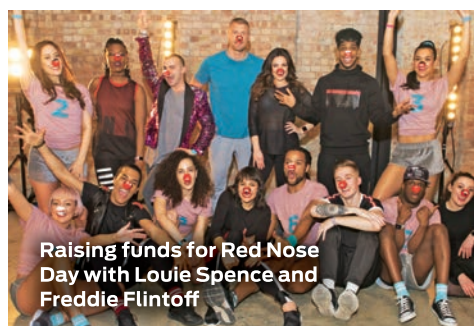
It's Kent through my eyes. I do live in a really pretty part of the world. There's not much else to do there other than take pictures and cook – it's quite remote. I don't mind the attention if I'm doing something that's a big deal, but I didn't think it was – talking about a few dresses on a morning show. I left and said: 'I don't really want to do this, it's a bit silly.'



You recently said that you should've kept your 2009 role on Britain's Got Talent. Would you go back if Simon Cowell invited you now?

I like Simon and everyone at *Britain's Got Talent*. I'm open to anything. It's a business and I don't really feel personal about things like that. It didn't work and I left. But if they wanted me to go back and things had changed, of course I'd go back. I don't really think about it, though.

Tell us about working with Fitbit to raise money for Comic Relief...

We've done a spoof of a pop video dance-off. Freddie Flintoff and I each have a crew of dancers and we try and outdo each other, but Louie Spence is the secret up my sleeve. Among those supporting her are her mum and dad, who separated before she was born, and her boyfriend Tom Gill, who she has been with for three years.

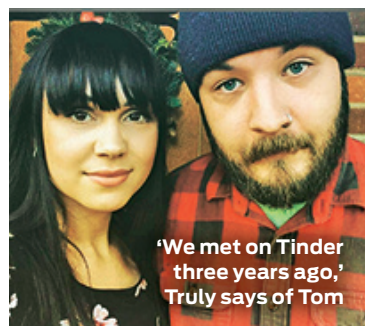
Here, Truly talks about getting to know Gavin and why she's determined to be this year's winner...

TANYA LACEY ON TRIUMPHING OVER ADVERSITY, CHAMPAGNE BOTTLES FROM BRUNO MARS AND FINALLY JOINING WILL.I.AM'S TEAM

Will.i.am doesn't often find himself speechless, but that's exactly how Tanya Lacey left *The Voice UK* coach after her blind audition, when she revealed she had co-written his hit track *THE (The Hardest Ever)*. When her unwitting collaborator didn't turn his chair for her, Tanya opted for team Gavin but in a plot twist, Will was quick to steal her at the battle stages.

After starting out in music at just 17, Tanya, who turns 31 this week, has featured on tracks with Tinchy Stryder and Loick Essien, as well as working with Emeli Sandé, and supported Bruno Mars on the European leg of his *Doo-Wops & Hooligans* tour.

The last two years have seen her take a break from the music industry to focus on youth music workshops in her hometown of Bristol.

Here, the singer – who is 'happily single' – tells us why she's ready to get her foot back in the door...

Why did you decide to audition for *The Voice UK*?

I took two years out from my music career. I just needed to find myself. I had a dark couple of years, rebuilt myself and started teaching and I realised I still had this passion to do it, so I thought, why not give the show a go? You are judged on the basis of your voice, and there is no distraction – the blind auditions were the most terrifying auditions I have ever done!

Why were those two years so dark?

Everything started to unravel – from my relationship to financial struggles. I couldn't afford to sustain the recording studio I had set up and I couldn't afford my rent. Everything just went to s**t and I had a lot of anxiety and depression that followed. I needed to take myself out of the industry and just get myself back.

After you co-wrote one of his hits, were you gutted when Will.i.am didn't turn around for you at the blind auditions?

No, I initially wanted Jennifer Hudson to turn for me. She has an incredible voice and she comes from such a humble background, but I'm glad it has gone the way it's gone. It was so surreal to actually meet Will for the first time. I wrote the song on a writing trip to Atlanta but the label I was signed to at the time [Sony RCA] didn't see any potential in it and he picked it up. It's great to hear it on the radio – I love it!

Has he spoken to you about not turning since he stole you back?

Yeah, he said he knew he wanted me on his team. That was a great plot twist for me. He didn't even let Emma Willis finish announcing it, he was just straight on the line. That urgency was so nice to see from him.

What was it like touring with Bruno Mars?

He was really accommodating and friendly. He got us a bottle of champagne and left a good luck note in my dressing room when I got there. He's so cool and I felt really welcome.

Has your industry experience given you an advantage in the competition?

Yes, experience is priceless and you can't buy it. It's definitely helping me at the moment in terms of nerves and the industry. You just don't get lost in the show.

Are you nervous about the upcoming live knockouts?

No, I'm so excited! I can't wait. Once you get past that blind audition, you find your rhythm. We're all in it together so it's tough when other people don't get through, but you just have to keep focusing on the prize because it's just a competition at the end of the day. ▶

'I LOOK UP TO WILL SO MUCH'

CLARA HURTADO TELLS US WHY SHE'LL NEVER SING A BLACK EYED PEAS TUNE AND REVEALS HER SISTER'S PLANS FOR FAME!

Serenading them in her native Spanish, Clara Hurtado won over all four coaches at her blind audition, before opting for a spot on Team Will.i.am. The singer spent her childhood in Madrid and Malaga before her family relocated to the UK back in July 2011.

Currently a second year music student at the British And Irish Modern Music Institute in Brighton, Clara lives with her parents and 17-year-old sister Ines in nearby Haywards Heath. The 20 year old also auditioned for *The X Factor* last year, but didn't make it through the first audition with producers.

Here, after a victorious battle round – despite being ill with a sore throat on the day – Clara tells *OK!* how boyfriend of five months Ben Killick, 19, has been her rock and why she'll never sing a Black Eyed Peas song in front of her mentor...

Why did you audition for *The Voice*?

Actually, I got a call from someone – I basically got scouted for it. She sent a recording of me to *The Voice* and they got back to her and they said did I want to audition. So I said, why not?

You're a huge Black Eyed Peas fan. Were you tempted to sing one of their songs for Will?

No! I will never have the courage to sing a Black Eyed Peas song, especially in front of Will! I look up to him so much.

All the coaches turned for you at the last minute in your blind audition. Were you surprised?

I had Will in mind beforehand and I only wanted one turn. Just before the song ended, I didn't think that I was going to get through at all. I had started really pitchy because I was super-scared!

What's Will like as a mentor?

Every rehearsal and any bit of filming, he's always there with the team. I haven't had a one-on-one with him but he likes to get down to work. I said to him that I was taking it a step at a time and he said that's the best way to be in this situation. He's

such a relaxed guy, so any advice is always so chilled.

What do your family and friends think of you doing the show?

They're really proud. My dad can't watch it without crying and he never normally cries. My sister is so excited. She really wants fame so she's happy [laughs]! She wants to be a make-up artist, so maybe we can work together one day.

What about your boyfriend, Ben?

He is super-proud. He's been my rock, however cringey that sounds. He's studying English at the moment but he loves music, too.

How did you guys meet?

We were in the same tutor group in school and then at college we had the same friendship group, but I didn't get to know him as we were both in relationships then. There was no

interest there until years after!

Are you worried about how much you'll get to see of him as the show progresses?

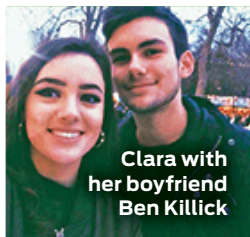
It will probably be a bit difficult if I get through the live shows because it's one after the other and it'll be a really busy month. But he's going to do his best to see me as much as he can.

Have you been recognised much since the show?

I went to an Into The Ark [also contestants on *The Voice*] gig and I think there was a girl looking at me weirdly and smiling at me. Sometimes people look at me in a funny way on the train, but no one actually comes and says hello [laughs]! I'm very humbled by everything. It hasn't all just slapped me in the face all at once. It's gradual.

What's the show's host, Emma Willis, like?

She is so lovely and such a delight to have around. She came up to our hair and make-up studio just to say hi. She was there without make-up and just super-casual.

'MY DAD HAD A FEW TEARS'

HAYLEY ECCLES ON LEAVING HER TOILET CLEANING JOB BEHIND AND HER SUPPORTIVE BEAU

Both Hayley Eccles and her father Geno took to the stage at the blind auditions. While her dad, 54, failed to win over the coaches, Hayley landed a spot on Team Will.i.am before sailing through the battle stages.

The fourth of Geno's five daughters, Hayley, 22, shares her family home in Lancashire with her parents and youngest sister. Also among her supporters is boyfriend of eight months, Daryl Smith, 26.

The singer also auditioned for *The X Factor* when she was 16, but only made it as far as the first producers stage. She admits: 'I was too young and I still had a lot of things to learn about my voice.'

Here, the hopeful talks to *OK!* about her supportive boyfriend and Will's words of wisdom...

Why did you audition for *The Voice*?

It was actually my dad – I didn't even know applications were open. He had filled out his form and then gave me mine. I thought it would be a nice dad and daughter day out!

Was it tough when he didn't get through?

It was the hardest thing to watch. He was not perfect. As soon as I got a turn I thought he was going to be heartbroken, knowing how long he's done it for and how passionate he is.

How did he react?

My dad doesn't ever cry, but he had a few tears rolling down! He was over the moon. He keeps



saying: 'Come on, you're doing it for the both of us.' I'm like: 'No pressure, Dad!'

What does your boyfriend Daryl think of you appearing on the show?

We met at the start of *The Voice* and he didn't know at first. We were out on our first date and I said I'm a singer on *The Voice* and he was like: 'What?!' He's been with me on this whole journey and he's so supportive. He's so proud of me.

What were you doing before the show?

I was gigging in pubs and local restaurants every weekend, sometimes with my dad, and doing cleaning jobs all week. From cleaning toilets to this is a bit of a difference, so I'm appreciating every single second!

How does it feel to be on Team Will?

I've always wanted him. I used to be obsessed with the Black Eyed Peas and I've always loved him. It was him or Jennifer Hudson for me. When we got given our battle song, he would stop me and make me speak out the words. He said: 'An actor is an actor because they act and a singer is a singer because they sing. But if you can get people to believe in what you're singing then you have now become both.' I was like, wow! How have I never thought of it like that?

Are you worried about the fact past winners haven't made it big in the music industry?

It makes me more motivated. I'm going to work my a**e off for it. You're not going to get this opportunity every time, so you have to work for it.

Her blind audition may have been met with mixed reactions, but Dannii Barnes has one person on her side – Sir Tom Jones. The star saw potential in the 20 year old from Guildford, despite criticism from Gavin Rossdale and Jennifer Hudson after her performance of *Tears* by Clean Bandit and Louisa Johnson. Luckily she managed to impress everyone during the battle round and is gearing up to take part in this weekend's live knockouts.

Before auditioning for the show, Dannii was juggling two jobs and is determined not to go back to her old life. Here she chats about being recognised on the train and her quest to find love...

During your blind audition, Gavin Rossdale and Jennifer Hudson said you changed your style too often – was that hard to hear? I think they were right. Looking back now the song choice was probably a mistake and my nerves got the better of me. I have no idea how I got through – when Tom turned around I thought it was a fix!



What were you doing before you auditioned?

I was working as a food runner for a catering company and selling jewellery in H Samuel. I did musical theatre as a kid – although I was pretty s**t – and I tried being in choirs but that didn't work out. I enrolled at the Academy of Contemporary Music in Guildford in August and I've just come back from two weeks singing at a ski resort.

How have you found *The Voice UK* so far?

Before my blind audition I was so nervous that I wanted to drop out, but I'm so glad I didn't. I come across as very confident, but I'm quite needy. I want everyone to love me.

Has anyone recognised you in the street yet?

It happened today for the first time! I was on a train and a woman came up to me and said she thought I was really good on the show. Everyone started looking at me!

What would you like to happen after the show is over?

I'd love a record contract because I can't pay my rent right now!

Are you dating anyone?

I'm seeing someone, but I'm not sure what's going to happen. I enjoy being in a relationship, it's the nicest feeling so I'm definitely looking for love. **OK!**

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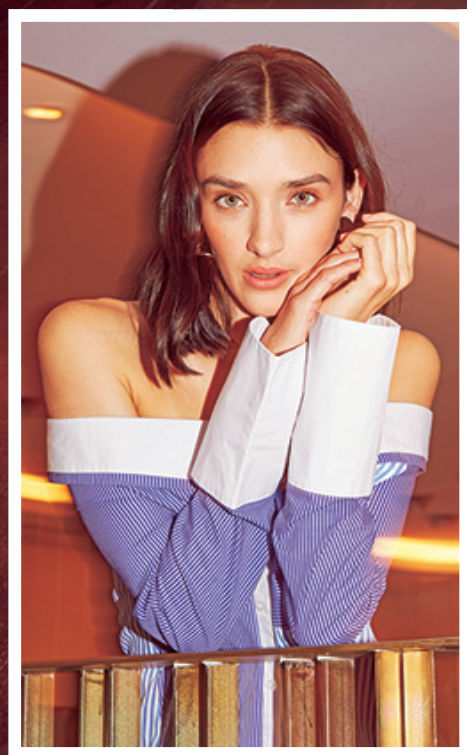

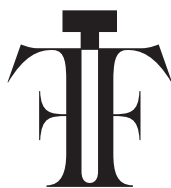

I swim a couple of times a week. When I was pregnant with Ernie, I got asked to leave a class because I was too pregnant and they said: 'Go swimming,' so I really got into it.



Has your attitude towards your body changed since becoming a mum?

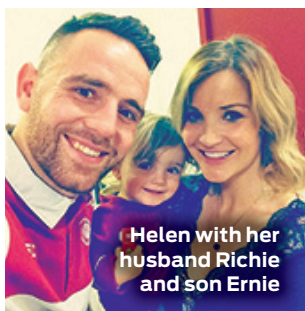
You're ambassador for British Lion Eggs. Why are eggs so important in your diet?

JK ROWLING

THE 'HARRY POTTER' AUTHOR WHO'S CAST A SPELL OVER THE WORLD



With the star of *Fantastic Beasts And Where To Find Them*, Eddie Redmayne

Oscar nominated for the film adaptation of her book, *Fantastic Beasts And Where To Find Them*, novelist JK Rowling has led a fairytale climb to fame and fortune. Through her fantasy children's franchise, *Harry Potter*, she rose from a life on benefits to become the celebrated author, playwright and icon that she is today. Her success and drive provided universal inspiration, and she once confessed: 'Rock bottom became the solid foundation on which I rebuilt my life.'

This year, the 51 year old celebrates the 20th anniversary of the book that ignited a legend. *Harry Potter And The Philosopher's Stone* was published by Bloomsbury after no less than 12 other publishers had rejected the manuscript. Now, with eight *Harry Potter* films, over 450 million book sales, a stage play and a theme park under her belt, the Twitter activist and troll slayer can turn her voice to politics.

A staunch Labour supporter, the anti-Trump tweeter has racked

up headlines for her fierce retorts and witticisms. After an article was written about a *Harry Potter* fan being so upset by JK's liberal views and Trump put-downs that she burned her *Potter* collection, a fellow critic tweeted: 'Glad I caught this article on Yahoo. I will now burn your books and movies too.' To which JK swiftly quipped: 'Well, the fumes from the DVDs might be toxic and I've still got your money, so by all means borrow my lighter.'

Born in Gloucestershire in 1965, Joanne Rowling's parents moved several times throughout her childhood. She describes herself as the kind of child that attracted bullies. 'I was the epitome of a bookish child, short and squat, thick National Health glasses, living in a world of complete daydreams,' she says. But by the time she was 18, the young Jo was heavily influenced by Siouxsie Sioux and The Smiths, and arrived at university to read Classics and French sporting jet black hair and heavy eyeliner.

Sadly, tragedy had struck three years earlier when her mother Anne was diagnosed with MS. Ten years after the diagnosis, Jo's mum passed away following her battle with the illness. Jo – whose relationship with her father, Peter, was and continues to be strained – moved to Portugal to teach English and within three years she'd married, given birth to her daughter Jessica, divorced, returned home and begun writing *Harry Potter And The Philosopher's Stone*.

What followed was a gruelling few years for the single mother, who was relying on benefits to scrape

Potter series. Is awarded an OBE. Marries Dr Neil Murray in secret.

2003 *Harry Potter And The Order Of The Phoenix* is published. Son David is born.

2004 *Forbes* names her as the first person to become a US billionaire by writing books.

2005 Daughter Mackenzie is born. *Harry Potter And The Half Blood Prince* is published.

2007 The final *Harry Potter* novel, *Harry Potter And The Deathly Hallows*, is published and becomes the fastest-selling book of all time. Publishes *The Tales Of Beedle The Bard* – nursery stories for young witches and wizards, as featured in the final *Harry Potter* book. All proceeds go to her children's charity, Lumos.

2010 The Wizarding World Of *Harry Potter* opens in Florida.

2011 Donates an estimated 16 per cent of her wealth to charity, which in turn bumps her from the *Forbes* billionaire list.

2012 Publishes dramatic novel *The Casual Vacancy*.

2013 *The Cuckoo's Calling* is published under pseudonym, Robert Galbraith.

2014 *The Silkworm* is published.

2016 Co-writes the play, *Harry Potter And The Cursed Child*, which opens in the West End. The film of *Fantastic Beasts And Where To Find Them*, starring Eddie Redmayne is released.

2017 *Fantastic Beasts* is awarded a BAFTA for Best Production Design.

through each day. She sent her manuscript to agents, and remembers: 'The first agent sent back a slip, saying: "My list is full. The folder you sent wouldn't fit in the [return] envelope." I really minded about the folder, because I had almost no money and had to buy another one.'

After getting an agent, she had 12 publishing companies reject the book before Bloomsbury agreed to print it, seven years after she started her first draft. But the writer has never seemed fazed, saying: 'It is impossible to live without failing at something, unless you've lived so cautiously that you might as well not have lived at all. In which case, you have failed by default.'

After taking her grandmother's name, Kathleen, for her middle



initial, the androgynous moniker JK Rowling – designed not to put off young male readers – was born. The first meagre print run flew off the shelves and in the same amount of time it had taken to see the first book in print, she had written a further five books, received numerous awards, an OBE, signed a film deal with Warner Bros, got remarried to Dr Neil Murray and had a son, David.

The following year, *Forbes* named her the first person to become a US billionaire from writing books, and her daughter Mackenzie was born the year after that in 2005.

It was a long way from Benefits Street, although the author will often joke about how her rags to riches story has sometimes been blown out of proportion, recalling: 'I had an American journalist say to me: "Is it true you wrote the whole of the first novel on napkins?" I was tempted to say: "On teabags, I used to save them."'

Famously selfless, the author has donated millions to charity. In fact, the reason she was bumped from the *Forbes* billionaires list was because she gave away 16 per cent of her net worth to good causes.

On the subject of charitable giving, she reasons: 'I think you

have a moral responsibility when you've been given far more than you need, to do wise things with it and give intelligently.'

The *Harry Potter* creator confesses her books are intentionally laced with socialist morals, advocating inclusivity and equality. Harry himself is an orphan, and Hermione from dual heritage, while Ron comes from a family teetering on the breadline.

'IT'S IMPOSSIBLE TO LIVE WITHOUT FAILING'

Anthony Gierzynski, author of *Harry Potter And The Millennials*, has carried out extensive research on the subject, writing: 'The evidence indicates that *Harry Potter* fans are more open to diversity and are more politically tolerant than non-fans; fans are also less authoritarian, less likely to support the use of deadly force or torture, more politically active, and more likely to have had a negative view of the Bush administration.'

Whispers that the *Harry Potter* series may be resurrected have been kiboshed by the writer herself. 'A rumour has made its way to the press that *Harry Potter And The Cursed Child* will be made into a film – and not just one film! A trilogy, with Dan, Emma and Rupert returning to their original roles, to be released in 2026,' she said, adding: 'I have no idea how these stories emerge, but to set the record straight: *Harry Potter And The Cursed Child* is a stage play, it was conceived and written as a stage play, it was always intended to be a stage play and nothing else, and there are absolutely no plans for it to become a movie, a novel, a puppet show, a cartoon, a comic book series or *Cursed Child On Ice*.'

THE PERSONAL TRAINER AND INSTAGRAM SENSATION BRINGS YOU TWO DELICIOUSLY HEALTHY MEALS

SWEET POTATO BURGERS WITH SMASHED AVOCADO, ROCKET AND PARMESAN

SERVES TWO

There's nothing more satisfying than some serious soul food on a Sunday evening. This usually involves some ice cream for me... But for starters, these sweet potato burgers are a pretty perfect end to the weekend. They're also great to cook once and eat twice, so making double of the recipe will ensure you've got a few lunches prepped for the week ahead.

Protein: There is no main source of protein within this dish, but there are some contributory sources – for example, the Parmesan cheese. Avocados also have a higher protein content than many other fruits.

Fats: The avocado in this dish provides an excellent source of healthy fats.

Micronutrients: Avocados are also a source of vitamin E, which helps protect our bodies against damage.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 large sweet potato, peeled (around 350g to 400g)
- ¼ lemon, juiced
- 1 tsp tahini
- ¼ tsp chilli flakes, plus extra to serve
- ¼ tsp smoked paprika
- ½ tsp garlic powder
- ¼ bunch of fresh coriander, leaves finely chopped
- 1 tbsp spelt flour
- ½ avocado, peeled, halved and stoned
- ¼ lime, juiced
- Large handfuls of rocket
- 2 tbsp pomegranate seeds
- 25g Parmesan cheese

O kay, we all love burgers, but this veggie twist on the meaty classic is an absolute winner for both meat eaters and veggies alike.

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C/350°F/Gas Mark 4. Line a baking tray with greaseproof paper.
2. Chop the potato into small chunks. Put into a medium saucepan, cover with cold water, bring to the boil, then reduce the heat to low and simmer for 20 minutes, until cooked through. Drain and leave to steam dry.
3. In a large bowl, mix together the lemon juice, tahini, chilli flakes, smoked paprika, garlic powder, chopped coriander and spelt flour with a pinch of salt and pepper. Add the

potato and mash with a potato masher until fully combined.

4. Once the mixture is cool enough to handle, use your hands to create two burgers. Place on the lined tray and cook in the hot oven for 20 minutes.
5. Meanwhile, put the avocado flesh into a bowl. Add the lime juice, a little salt and pepper and a pinch of chilli flakes, and mash until fully combined.
6. Serve the burgers with a large handful of rocket. Top with the smashed avocado, sprinkle over the pomegranate seeds and use a vegetable peeler to shave over the Parmesan.

MUSHROOM AND MOZZARELLA SHAKSHUKA

SERVES TWO



INGREDIENTS

- 2 tbsp coconut oil
- 1 large red onion, peeled, halved and diced
- 1 garlic clove, peeled and minced
- 15 button mushrooms, halved
- 1 tsp smoked paprika
- ½ tsp ground cumin
- ½ aubergine, chopped
- 400g tinned chopped tomatoes
- 4 free range eggs
- 100g mozzarella, cut into chunks
- ¼ bunch of fresh coriander, leaves chopped
- Sea salt and freshly ground black pepper

This is a delicious alternative to the classic shakshuka. Featuring the always-delicious gooey mozzarella, it's an absolute winner of a dish!

1. Begin by heating the coconut oil in a large non-stick frying pan over a medium-low heat until melted.

2. Add the onion, garlic, mushrooms, spices, aubergine and a pinch of salt and pepper and cook for 15 minutes, stirring occasionally.

3. Add the chopped tomatoes and cook for a further 15 minutes, stirring occasionally.

4. Using a spoon, make four shallow wells in the tomato sauce, then crack an egg into each well.

5. Evenly scatter over the mozzarella, cover with a lid and continue to cook until the egg whites have set and the egg yolks are cooked to your liking.

6. Serve scattered with the chopped coriander. **OK!**

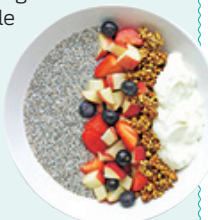

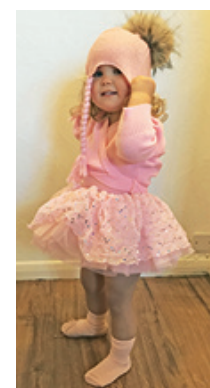

OK! SLOPES OFF TO THE FRENCH ALPS FOR A SPOT OF SKIING AND HEAPS OF STAR SPOTTING

With its spectacular mountain setting high up in the French Alps, British skiers have been flocking to Val d'Isère for years. The resort not only offers some of the world's most challenging ski terrain but also one of the longest ski seasons, stretching from November to May. However, it's not all about skiing in Val, as it's affectionately known, as the resort also boasts some legendary après-ski spots as well as gourmet dining, high-end boutiques and wintery pursuits such as ice driving, snow shoeing, snowmobiling and ice skating, as OK!'s Lauren Ozzati discovered...

WHICH STARS MIGHT I SEE?

Val d'Isère attracts everyone from reality stars to British royals. Jamie Oliver learned to ski at the resort and takes his family back there, while *Made In Chelsea* stars Binky Felstead and Francesca Newman-Young were on the slopes in Val last year and were seen partying at La Folie Douce with former rugby star Thom Evans. One Direction's Louis Tomlinson was also spotted getting cosy with his former girlfriend Danielle Campbell in the resort last year.

WHERE CAN I SKI?

The Espace Killy mountain area features more than 300km of marked pistes – with a network

of lifts that also connect to the neighbouring resort of Tignes – which are perfectly suited to intermediate or advanced skiers. There are plenty of off-piste guides to take powder-hounds in search of fresh snow and there's a snowpark for boarders to show off their tricks. There are several new magic-carpet lifts servicing Ski Tranquil areas at the top of the Solaise mountain which are ideal for beginners. Looking forward to getting on to the slopes, OK! quickly discovered that mountain weather is never predictable. As 44cm of fresh snow fell in a 12-hour white-out forcing the ski lifts to close, we found ourselves holed up at our chalet. But with its indoor pool, cinema and spa there was plenty to keep us entertained!

WHERE CAN I STAY?

The VIP treatment started the moment OK! touched down in Geneva, where our private chauffeur, employed by Brit-owned luxury chalet company Consensio, picked us up for the scenic three-hour journey to the resort, passing pristine winter scenes of shimmering lakes and snow-dusted villages on the way. For Consensio guests – including British skier Chemmy Alcott, who stayed at the plush Marco Polo chalet – a chauffeur is at your disposal for the duration

of your stay, while more staff are on hand 24/7 to cater for guests' every whim.

When OK! stepped through the snowy porch and into the warmth of Chalet Calistoga, where we were led through to the dramatic double-height lounge to find afternoon tea laid out in front of the crackling fire, we knew we were somewhere special. Floor-to-ceiling windows teased us with picture-perfect views of the Alps blanketed in snow as we nibbled on dainty warm mushroom and truffle tarts and chocolate muffins and sipped champagne. Chalet Calistoga sleeps ten people over five bedrooms, with a lavish open-plan lounge and dining room, cosy snug and a spa area complete with sauna, massage room and a pool that opens out onto a patio. With an abundance of wood, a scattering of plush cushions, knitted throws and flickering candles, Calistoga perfectly captures that feeling of luxury hygge.

WHERE CAN I EAT?

Before you arrive at the resort, Consensio's staff contact guests to find out their food likes, dislikes and allergies, so the chef can devise suitable menus. New for this season is the breakfast menu that's been created by Tom Cenci, executive chef of London's Duck And Waffle. As well as the standard breakfast fare, the menu offers bespoke dishes such as the delicious duck egg en cocotte with melted Gruyère cheese, wild mushrooms and aromatic shaved truffles. Evenings at Calistoga start off with fireside canapés before sitting down to a five-course dinner cooked by the chalet's private

chef, Jamie Tully. Menu highlights included pan-fried scallops, tender lamb loin with pea purée, tornados of beef with sauce Bordelaise and the dark and white chocolate fondant with peanut brittle and cardamom ice cream.

While out on the slopes, OK! stopped off for lunch at La Tête de Solaise, which serves hearty French and

Savoyarde dishes such as the creamy tartiflette made with local cheeses, steak frites and French onion soup. If you can't make up your mind on dessert, order the chef's selection of mini desserts. For lunch in the resort, OK! shared a fondue at the buzzy La Baraque, and admired the restaurant's funky décor of heavy steel mirrors, stag heads wearing ski goggles and industrial copper lighting.

WHERE SHOULD I GO FOR APRES-SKI?

For party animals, there is only one place to head for après-ski – La Folie Douce, famous for its wild parties on the outdoor

terrace and dancing on the tables in ski boots. You can hear the music long before you reach this mountain-side party hotspot, which shares a space with La Fruitière, a restaurant housed in an old dairy. OK! sipped our drink as we watched saxophonists play alongside the resident DJ, while dancers dressed in leggings and faux fur strutted their stuff on the roof! Luckily, for those who have overindulged and don't fancy skiing home, the La Daille gondola is just next door.

Down in the resort, the iconic Dick's Tea Bar, with its VIP area and pumping DJ, is always heaving. Girls Aloud singer Sarah Harding was recently spotted letting her hair down on the dancefloor. Not

for the faint-hearted, the revelry doesn't really kick off until after midnight and the club doesn't close until 4am. So prepare yourself for a sore head on the slopes the following day!

HOW DO I GET THERE?

Consensio Chalets (www.consensiochalets.co.uk) offers 13 chalets and two new self-catered apartments in the French Alps. Chalet Calistoga in Val d'Isère costs from £17,500 for a week, based on ten guests sharing five rooms on a fully inclusive basis.

EasyJet (www.easyjet.com) flies from 14 UK airports to Geneva, up to seven days per week, with prices starting from £18.49 per person one way, including tax. **OK!**
