WHERE DID WE GO?

Vomo Island, one of the more than 300 that make up the nation of Fiji. It's a long trip to get there from the U.S., but the island vibe hits you long before you land thanks to Fiji Airways, which imbues every element of your flight with Fijian culture.

WHERE DID WE STAY?

Vomo Island, a 255-acre paradise that's a short helicopter ride away from the airport. The resort is the only thing on the island, so visiting means you're getting away from it all. But if you want to qet even farther away from it all, fear not: You can rent Vomo Lai Lai—or Little Vomo—and have the nearby island all to yourself. (If you run out of champagne, don't sweat it. Just call the resort on your two-way radio and they'll send some over.)

WHAT DID WE DO?

Went snorkeling among the reefs, relaxed on the white beaches and swam in the pristine blue and green water. We also did a little fishing. Hannah caught a Spanish mackerel, a kingfish and a trevally—which led to an exquisite sashimi lunch courtesy of the resort's chef. Don't worry, though: You're not expected to catch your own meal. The resort has plenty of food that is light, fresh and sublime.

WHAT DID WE **BRING HOME?**





WHERE DID WE GO?

Tulum, a town on Mexico's Caribbean coast near the ruins of a Mayan fortress city. (*Tulum* is the Mayan word for wall.) It's 80 miles south of Cancún on the Yucatán peninsula.

WHERE DID WE STAY?


At a gorgeous estate with a modernity that complements the historic tenor of the surroundings: Casa Malca. This contemporary beachfront hotel is a converted house owned by New York City art gallerist Lio Malca. There are 11 rooms in the house and 30 more on the grounds.) Malca has decorated the property with works of modern art, so you can have a drink in a bar festooned with Keith Haring wallpaper. The house was built with native materials by local craftsmen, and that eco-friendliness is evident in everything at the hotel, from the food to the linens.

WHAT DID WE DO?

Visited—and shot at the nearby cenotes, natural underwater limestone passages. The area is perfect for swimming, fishing and kite surfing, but the Caribbean coast isn't just about beach life. In addition to exclusive boutiques and clubs, there's a burgeoning culinary scene, with chefs giving traditional dishes sophisticated makeovers.

WHAT DID WE BRING HOME?

Dream catchers, string bracelets—and a new way of thinking about those bare walls of ours at home.

























ZAZA



WHERE DID WE GO?

Deep in the heart of Texas: Houston, the locale of World Champions Centre, the gym where four-time Olympic gold medalist Simone Biles trains. And we'll be going back to H-Town this month for VIBES by Sports Illustrated Swimsuit, a two-day festival of music (Diplo! Miguel!), food (nationally celebrated chefs!) and fun (models!) at The Post HTX event space.

WHERE DID WE STAY?

Hotel ZaZa, a gorgeous boutique hotel in Houston's bustling Museum District.

WHAT DID WE DO?

Ate at Underbelly, the amazing restaurant run by James Beard Award-winning local chef Chris Shepherd. It's named for what lurks beneath the city's surface; Houston is one of the most diverse cities in the U.S. and Shepherd's cuisine draws on a variety of cultures. All of the ingredients are fresh and all of the meat is butchered in-house, so the menu varies daily. But trust us-whatever Shepherd gets his hands on is delicious. He has put together an all-star array of chefs to provide the fare at VIBES, including restaurateurs (and Top Chef judges Graham Elliot and Hugh Acheson.

WHAT DID WE **BRING HOME?**

An overwhelming desire to return and have even more fun. Luckily we will do just that—and you can join us. Full details are available at si.com/ swimsuitvibes.






































WHERE DID WE GO?

Santa's Winter Wonderland for Adults-better known as Lapland in Finland, which became the northernmost location ever to host a Swimsuit shoot.

WHERE DID WE STAY?

Kakslauttanen Arctic Resort, which is located 150 miles north of the Arctic Circle (but only half an hour from the nearest airport). Few places in the world are better to view the majesty of the Northern Lights. And at Kakslauttanen, you can bask in their beauty from the comfort of your own bed if you stay in one of the resort's iconic glass igloos. (If you prefer something more rustic, there are log chalets. If you're torn, there are Keloglass chalets, a hybrid of the two.)

WHAT DID WE DO?

A lot of reindeerrelated pursuits, including a safari. The resort also offers saunas as well as activities such as ice fishing, cross-country skiing and, in the summer, canoeing and kayaking. Oh, and you can meet Santa and even stay in his home, at Kakslauttanen. But only if you're on the big quy's nice list, not the naughty one. (Which list are we on? Mind your own business.)

WHAT DID WE **BRING HOME?**

Christmas ornaments and reindeer pelts. Plus, some powder made from ground reindeer horns, which is said to increase one's, um, potency. (So much for getting off that naughty list.)

WHAT DID WE DO?

Paid a visit to the island's most famous inhabitant, Christie Brinkley. Her home, Lucky House, sits on the beach and is beautifully decorated throughout with shells that were found on the sands. Our hostess also welcomed her daughters, and the three of them had a blast together. (Fittings aren't always fun for models, but they treated it like a mom and her two kids playing dress-up.) We also found out that Alexa Ray inherited some serious vocal chops from her dad, Billy Joel. She serenaded us with "Part of Your World," from The Little Mermaid.

White sand, shells, beach-scented candles and a much-needed sense of relaxation.



WHERE DID WE GO?

Sumba Island, one of 17,508 that make up Indonesia.

WHERE DID WE STAY?

Oh, only at the hotel that was voted No. 1 in the world by Travel and Leisure in 2016: the marvelously elegant Nihiwatu. And thanks to owner Christopher Burch, who bought the property after visiting it with his three sons, a portion of the resort's profits are sent to the Sumba Foundation. which fosters community-based projects to provide the Sumbanese people with improved healthcare, nourishment and education.


WHAT DID WE DO?

We enjoyed horseback riding and a visit to the fascinating traditional village of Tarung. You can spend some time in paradise at nearby Nihi Oka, where a spa day kicks off with a 90-minute hike to breakfast served in a tree platform. And then there's the surfing. Sumba is home to Occy's Left (also known as God's Left), one of the most sought-after waves in the world. It breaks right in front of Nihiwatu—and only quests can grab one of the 10 coveted slots given to surfers each day. We were lucky enough to snag a few spots and Hailey wowed us on the waves.

WHAT DID WE **BRING HOME?**

Hand-carved Sumba warrior swords, plus beautiful locallywoven blankets and throws dyed using the ikat technique.

WHERE DID WE GO?

Anguilla, a Caribbean oasis that takes its name from the Spanish word for eel, which describes the island's shape.

WHERE DID WE STAY?

The Reef by CuisinArt, a member of Small Luxury Hotels of the World, which marries Caribbean luxury (standing in the open-air lobby gives one the sensation of being on a yacht) with an urban flair (the swimming pool has a DJ). If all that doesn't chill you out enough, there's a luxurious 27,000-squarefoot spa.

WHAT DID WE DO?


Rode bikes, swam, snorkeled and kayaked—in a glassbottomed boat. Guests can also take advantage of preferred tee times at the nearby Greq Normandesigned golf course. (We thought about having bodypainter Joanne Gair draw some fresh golf slacks on us and hit the links, but we decided that might be too much work.) We also ate incredibly fresh—and delicious-meals. The on-site hydroponic farm provides farm-totable ingredients. The seafood is Caribbeanto-table. And in our case, that went both ways. We were so overwhelmed by a giant lobster (we named him Sebastian) that we decided he was too beautiful to eat. So we released him on a reef in front of the hotel.

WHAT DID WE **BRING HOME?**

Sand, shells and a new sensitivity toward marine life.



WHERE DID WE GO?

Curação, a small island off the northern coast of South America that is part of the kingdom of the Netherlands. There's only one major city, Willemsted (a UNESCO Heritage Site that's packed with stunning Europeanstyle architecture, restaurants and museums), but the island is a melting pot. More than 50 cultures are represented, and most of Curaçao's 150,000 residents speak four languages: English, Spanish, Dutch and Papiamento (a local tongue).

WHERE DID WE STAY?

Our feeling when it comes to hotels is that if it's good enough for royalty, it's good enough for us. And Avila Beach Hotel is where the Dutch royal family stays when on Curaçao. It's easy to see why. The country's oldest hotel, which dates to 1780, offers the best of all worlds—two private beaches, but with a central location that allows quests to soak up the atmosphere in the vibrant Pietermaai district.

WHAT DID WE DO?


Relaxed on the pristine, covelike beaches (there are more than 35 on the island). Rookie Vita showed her mettle by diving off a cliff. Oh, and we rode an ostrich. For real. (One rider likened it to "a bicycle that has one wheel that's, like, loose.")




