

The stars of the new series of Celebs Go Dating tell us about their experiences so far - and it's not for the faint-hearted!

ur favourite dating show is back, and when we catch up with This Morning reporter Ferne McCann, Pussycat Doll Melody Thornton, reality star Joey Essex, Diversity dancer Perri Kiely and Ex On The Beach's Stephen Bear, we get the feeling this series of Celebs Go Dating will be even more compulsive viewing than the first. Dating experts Nadia Essex and Eden Blackman are also back to help the famous singles find their perfect match - along with fabulous receptionist Tom Read Wilson.

When we sit down to chat to the cast (minus Jorgie Porter and Jonathan Cheban, who couldn't make it), it's clear the mayhem has already started.

Ferne, 26, opens up about the emotional hardships of her quest for love, Perri, 21, confesses he's never been on a date before and Joey, 26, tells us he's learnt nothing from his last time on the show!

Meanwhile, saucy Melody, 32, reveals she just wants some regular sex and Bear, 27, admits

he's doing it for the money. And, of course, he's already dating his Just Tattoo Of Us co-star Charlotte Crosby...

Hi guys! Why did you want to put your dating life on screen? Joey: Well, obviously I didn't find love the first time...

Ferne: I'm finding the search for love quite depressing. I'm 27 in August and I'm looking to settle down. My friends are moving in with their partners, some of them are on their second baby, and I'm just moving out of my mum's. It makes me feel quite sad. Perri: I'm looking for someone.

Before the show, I'd never actually been on a date. I've been thrown in the

deep end and it's the strangest thing I have ever done. Melody: I'm just trying to get some sex on a regular basis,

because I'm so

busy! I haven't even kissed anyone yet, though.

Bear: I've come for the money. I say the truth, baby, they pay me good.

What kind of partner are you looking for?

Bear: She can't be obsessed with social media. And she can't have a hairy fanny. It's 2017, there's no excuse. The Hollywood. Shaved bum hole. Everything gone, smelling lovely.

Melody: I like someone who's ambitious and has some money. Ferne: I want to be a team with someone. My perfect quy? I want him to text me 50 times a day, I want to FaceTime him a minimum five times a day. I want to make love every single day, I

want to feel love. I don't want a pussy boy.

Perri: I'm learning as I'm going. If there's a spark, there's a spark. Selena Gomez is hot! Someone who looks like her would be great.

Joey: A girl who is an absolute weapon. I'm looking for a ten out of ten. I feel like last time I put myself in a bit of a corner with just one person. I put all my eggs in one basket, which was probably not the best idea. It got so serious and I went full steam ahead.

Do you still speak to your exes? Melody: Yep. They go away and then they think, "She was so great!" Then they come back and I'm like, "No, but we can be friends." And it ends up being a great friendship. Joey: Not really, no. I don't speak to any of my exes. Not naming

I don't hold grudges, but usually it's the girl who gets a bit obsessive and me who ends it. Bear: No, my exes hate me, I don't know why. They've got a real problem with me. It's thought the pair have been growing close for some time, but have been keeping things under



KHLOÉ PLAGUED BY HER 'CHUBBY' PAST



"They need to grow apart so that they can congratulate from a small distance, rather than feeling their own status is under threat."



Model Amy Willerton will replace the Irish DJ. Amy, 24, said, "I hope I can do Vogue proud!"



The 48-year-old singer is said to have thrown Josh, 29, out of her west London home after growing increasingly worried by his closeness to Spanish actress Marta Milans, 34, after they filmed TV series No Tomorrow together in Canada last year.

Confirming the split on Instagram, Kylie wrote, "#lovers... Thank you for all your love and support throughout this recent chapter of my life. Thank you now for your love and understanding with the news that Josh and I have decided to go our separate ways.

"We wish only the best for each other as we venture towards new horizons. #thesunalwaysrises.'

A source says Kylie, who has ditched her engagement ring, is "utterly heartbroken"

and "devastated" at the sudden split. The Aussie star met Josh in 2015 on the set of TV show Galavant and announced their engagement in February last year. She even revealed just last month that she would adopt his surname when they married, gushing, "I'll definitely be taking Sasse."

A source was reported to have claimed the relationship

was lying to her. "She really believed he was The One. But she no longer trusts him," an insider revealed.

Josh is now said to be living back in his family home in Herefordshire, with a source explaining, "It was when she was in Paris that Kylie became suspicious and returned to London to confront Joshua. She immediately asked him to leave her home, which he had moved into at the start of the relationship."


Star contacted both Kylie and Joshua's reps with the allegations of cheating, but neither replied.
